IN BECOMING PRESIDENT AND MAJORITY OWNER OF NEW YORK UNITED, JIMMY SORRENTINO HAS REACHED THE PINACLE OF SOCCER FANDOM.

AN ITALIAN BORN YOUNGSTER GROWING UP IN BRAZIL, HE LEARNED THE SPORT AND PLAYED SEMI-PROFESSIONALLY AS RECENTLY AS 10 YEARS AGO.

AFTER COMING TO THE UNITED STATES IN 1960, SORRENTINO BEGAN HIS RISE IN THE OIL INDUSTRY WITH ONE GAS STATION. HE NOW OWNS SAV-ON OIL AND CHRISTIAN PETROLEUM, WITH 26 GAS STATIONS IN THE METROPOLITAN AREA.

HIS GOAL IS TO BRING TOP PROFESSIONAL SOCCER TO NEW YORK, AND TO SOMEDAY HAVE A COMPLETELY AMERICAN TEAM. THE 45 YEAR OLD SORRENTINO LIVES IN NEW YORK WITH HIS WIFE MICHELINE, AND 10 YEAR OLD SON CHRISTIAN, WHOM HE NAMED HIS OIL COMPANY FOR.

NEW YORK UNITED'S BUSY FRONT OFFICE EXECUTIVE HAS BEEN INVOLVED IN PROFESSIONAL SOCCER FOR MORE THAN 25 YEARS AS A PLAYER, COACH, PROMOTER AND GENERAL MANAGER.

MAGNOZZI, WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES SOCCER FEDERATION HALL OF FAME, THE AMERICAN SOCCER LEAGUE HALL OF FAME AND THE PUBLIC SCHOOL ATHLETIC LEAGUE HALL OF FAME, HAS BROUGHT MANY FAMOUS FOREIGN TEAMS TO THE UNITED STATES. HIS PROMOTIONS HAVE INCLUDED PELE, EUSEBIO, INTER MILAN, MILAN WITH GAMES AT YANKEE STADIUM, RANDALL'S ISLAND, THE LOS ANGELES COLISEUM AND SOLDIER'S FIELD IN CHICAGO.
