## TRADERS TRIMMINGS

A little background on new Traders' skipper Paul Jerome "P.J." Carey..He's 28, single, from Scranton, Pa. Played in Pulaski, Va.; Auburn, N.Y.; Spartanburg (1974-75) and Rocky Mount, NC. Carey didn't reach the big leagues, but played in both Phillie Stadiums (Connie Mack and the Vet) as an American Legion All-Star...new pitching coach Ellis "Cot" Deal is a 59-year-old Oklahoman who pitched and played outfield over an 18-season career. He reached the majors with the Red Sox in 1947-48 and Cardinals in 1950 and '54. He managed 6 years of Class AAA, coached and scouted on and off since 1959...Mel Roberts is due to return to coaching from Peninsula Friday...Vinnie Soreca never pitched before in his life, but has thrown shutout ball in all seven appearances since his conversion from catching...Lefty John Machin is due off the disabled list shortly.
