The way the Skipjacks ended the 1985 year is hopefully a sign of things to come in 1986. On New Year's Eve, the Skipjacks ended a 3-game losing streak and won their first game at home since Nov.13, by shutting out the Sherbrooke Canadiens 6-0. The 6-goal margin of victory tied a season high, and was BRIAN FORD's 4th career pro shut-out, his first as a Skipjack. Ford has lost only twice in his last 9 appearances and has a 2.78 goals-against average in that span.

**BALTIMORE SKIPJACKS (11-23-3):** Win on Tues night marked end of 9-game winless streak at home...Jacks defense has come to fore of late, having allowed only 2 power play goals in last 5 gms, killing off pp opportunities at a rate of 92% (2ppg-23 opps). ..c-MITCH LAMOUREUX is playing in his 200th career Skipjacks game tonight. He ranks 3rd on the Jacks all-time list behind ROB GEALE (228) and PHIL BOURQUE (234)...lw-TOM ROULSTON was named yesterday as Skipjacks "Player of the Month" for December.



**MONCTON GOLDEN FLAMES (15-15-3):** First of four meetings between these two clubs...Second game of 6-game road trip for Flames...Defeated Binghamton 5-4 on New Year's Eve, ending the Whalers 10-game unbeaten streak...Have lost only once in last 7 games (5-1-1), & have won last 3 in a row...Is only team in AHL to have scored fewer goals than Skipjacks (120, Jacks-127), but is strong defensive club, 3rd in league in goals allowed (129).

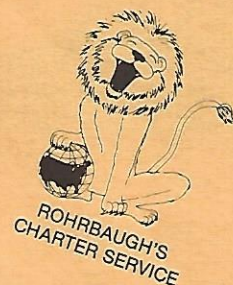

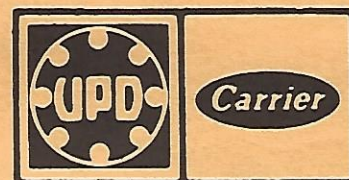

## Fans' Scorecard

HOW TO SCORE A **JACKS** GAME—Keeping an account of tonight's game is easy since the scoreboard and the PA announcer will provide you with all pertinent information.

**REFEREE AND LINESMEN** — The names of the 3 on-ice officials will be announced prior to the start of the game.

**SCORING** — When a goal is scored, enter the new score of the game in the first column, JACKS' total goals first. Next, indicate in which period the goal was scored and the time. In hockey, time is announced as elapsed time in the period. Place the initial of the team scoring the goal, the name of the player who scored it, and those assisting (if any) in the remaining columns.

**PENALTIES**—Indicate the period and the time of the penalty, the initial of the team guilty of the infraction, and the player's name who committed the penalty. Complete your entry by writing the number of minutes assessed and the infraction.

**GOALS AND SHOTS ON GOAL**—At the end of each period, place the number of goals scored by each team and the shots on goal in the appropriate box. The shots on goal totals will be announced over the PA system after the period ends.

**THREE STARS**—At the end of the game, the players viewed by the media as the top three will have their names announced. Enter their names in the special section.

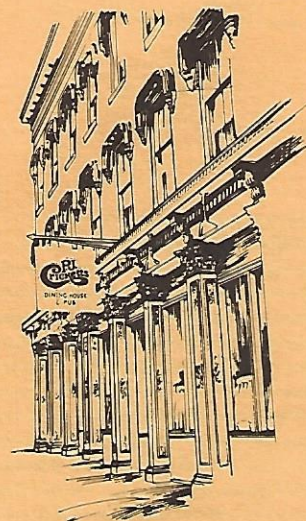
