POSITION---SIXTH IN SOUTH...UPCOMING GAMES---11/13 @ NH, 11/16 vs. BING.


DEVILS' NOTEBOOK---The top farm club of the New Jersey Devils, the Utica Devils make their first visit of the season to the Springfield Civic Center...Tonight's game is the first of a six game season series between these two inter-divisional rivals...The Devils have struggled during the intial portions of the 1988-89 season with a mark of 4-7-0 at press time. After winning the first game of the season, the Devils proceeded to drop the next five in a row before playing .500 hockey since that skein.

COACHING---Tom McVie enters his fifth season as the Coach of the New Jersey Devils' top minor league affiliate...Prior to last season he guided the Devils' prospects in Maine...Has coached in the NHL with, New Jersey, Washington and Winnipeg.

IN THE NETS---At this writing the Devils' number one goaltender, Chris Terreri is on recall to New Jersey...Third year pro, Craig Billington has played in just three games at 6.83 GAA...Second year pro Dan Delianedis has yet to play a game this season for Utica.

ON DEFENSE---Anchoring a very young Utica back-line is Murray Brumwell...
Brumwell is in his ninth year as a pro and has been an all-star performer in the AHL...Last season selected to the AHL's second team with, 13-53-66 pts in 77 games...The rest of the "D" crew is made up of first and second year performers.

UP FRONT---The Devils' player of the month for October was center, Paul Ysebaert with 7-9-16 pts in 10 games during the season's first month... Finnish wing, Janne Ojanen is off to a fine start with 15 pts (4-11) in the team's first 11 games...Right wing, Chris Cichocki and center, Tim Lenardon provide plenty of offense up front for Tom McVie... Currently on recall to New Jersey is LW, Anders Carlsson...Left wing, George McPhee is set to come off the injured list.


