The Baltimore Skipjacks return from a three-game road trip with three one-goal losses which extended their club-record winless streak to 10 games (0-9-1). They will look to snap a four-game losing streak against a tough Hershey club which has won three in a row and four of their last five. Hershey, the oldest club in the AHL, has won nine division championships in its 48-year history, the latest coming in 1980-81. The last two seasons have been weak ones for the Bears (6th&7th place), but they enter tonight's game trailing the division-leading Rochester Americans by only 4 points.

Hershey and Baltimore are the league's top two teams in total penalty minutes, and include the league's top three penalty-leaders - WALLY WEIR (145), STEVE MARTINSON (143) and CARL MOKOSAK (134).

Of league's Top Ten Scorers, only two (9th&10th) are from Northern Division...#1 scorer in AHL is St. Cath's WES JARVIS with 54 pts (19g,35a). Last season at this time the #1 scorer had 32 pts (Ray Cote, NS, 19g,13a). Jarvis had 26 pts....Hershey has top power play % in AHL (26%)....There have been five shut-outs recorded in AHL this season.


