THE MOD LOOK OF THE PIRATES

When the Pirates took the field for opening night at Hyde Park Stadium, the beautifully conditioned stadium wasn't the only attraction, as the players were attired in a brand new kind of baseball uniform.

The revolutionary new garb, made by Rawlings Sporting Goods Company, is a unique double-knit construction of sixty percent nylon and forty percent cotton. It features a natty, form-hugging slip over shirt and tailored pants with elastic waist-band. In addition to their light comfortable weight, the uniforms are easily cleaned without dry cleaning.

The home uniform is white (road uniform—gray) with black, white and old gold trim around the sleeves and waistband and black and old gold trim around the collar. The socks are of solid black, old gold and white starting at the stirrup on up.

The lettering of "Pirates" on the front of the pullover shirt is done in Old English, black on old gold with player numbers under the lettering on the left side and on the back also black on old gold.

The cap is old gold with a black Old English 'NF' with a black button and black visor.
