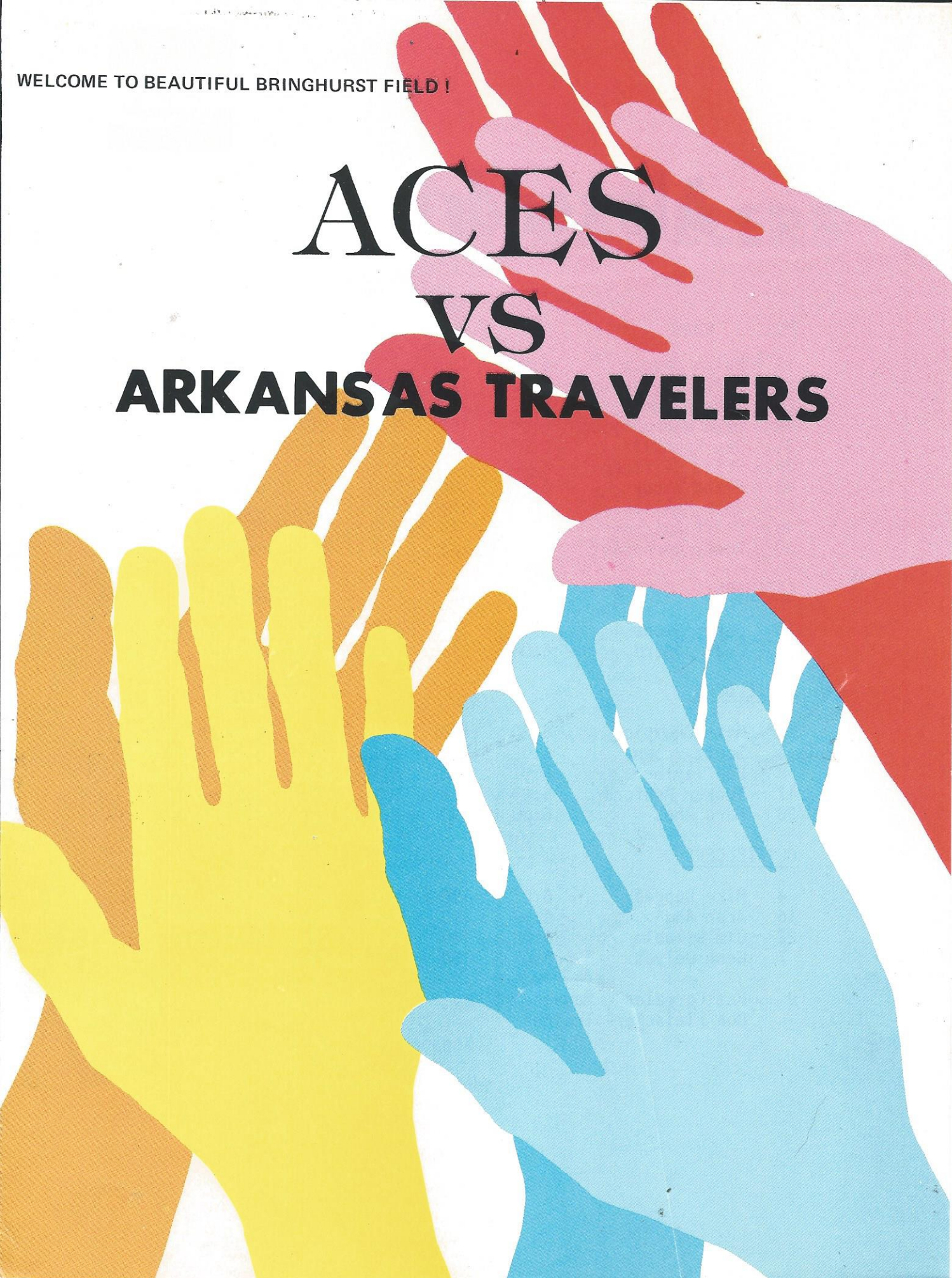

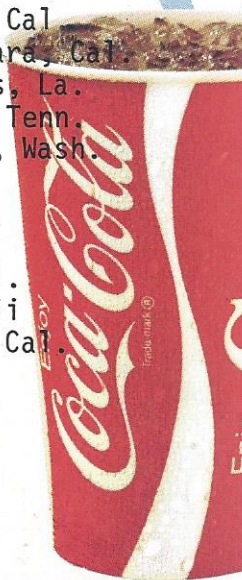

The Aces will stage an abbreviated homestand Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday against the Arkansas Travelers.

The Travelers, as usual provide a very formidable opponent. They are led by 24 year old outfielder Mike Potter who is hitting at an even .300 clip. The Travs also feature former Northwestern Louisiana star Bob Hrapmann at shortstop. Hrapmann is hitting .281. . .He will once again resume his rivalry with Aces shortstop Bobby Taylor. . .The two were high school and college rivals and have now reached the Texas League. This is the third series between the two teams.
