Profile:

Winner of 35 national net titles, Dennis was a member of the U.S. Davis Cup Team from 1960-1966 and the captain-coach since he was 29, the youngest man to hold that position. Dennis coached the team to victory in 1968-69, and as captain-coach, the squad won the cup in 1972 and 1973. Ralston was already ranked as number 1 in the U.S. for 3 years before he turned pro in 1966. At 18, he was the youngest player in history to win the Wimbledon doubles in 1960 with Mexico's Rafael Osuna.

In 1970 he was ranked 10th in the world. Dennis has won such titles as the NCAA Singles and Doubles, National Clay Court Singles and Doubles, U.S. National Doubles as well as the French National Doubles. A knee operation kept him out of action in 1972, but Dennis has been making a great return in 1974 by defeating Italy's number one player, Adriano Panatta in the Kemper Classic and in the Hawaii Leis' \$10,000 Invitational.

A right hander with an outstanding forehand volley, Dennis has defeated the best players in the game, such as Rod Laver, Ken Rosewall, Stan Smith and more. During the season he will be residing in Hawaii with his wife and 3 children.

Obtained through a three way trade, the Hawaii Leis couldn't ask for a more qualified coach or player.

An up and coming young player with victories over Tom Okker of the Tornoto-Buffalo Royals, Roger Taylor of the Boston Lobsters and John Newcombe of the Houston EZ Riders, Ross was a member of the Australia Davis Cup Team in 1971 and 1972 and now the World Championship of Tennis pro troupe. In 1972, Case won the Queensland and South Australian Doubles with Geoff Masters. Ross and Geoff, who has signed with L. A., won the Australian Open Doubles in December 1973, and he is presently ranked among the top men in Australia. A right hander, Case will be used both in singles and doubles.

Ranked number 10 in the nation for women's singles and number 2 in doubles with Wendy Overton of the Toronto-Buffalo Royals, Valerie has been a successful competitor for years. For 3 years running, she was the USLTA's Girls' Doubles Champion, 1965-1967, and in 1969 won the USLTA's Homen's Doubles Champion with Mary Ann Eisel. In 1969, 1971 and 1972, she was a member of the prestigious Wightman Cup Team for the U.S. (1-0 in singles, 2-1 in doubles), and in 1972 was part of the U.S. Federation Cup team. She was undefeated with a 4-0 in singles. The 1973 Virginia Slims Circuit saw Valerie reach the semi-finals twice early in the season and then continue to reach the quarter-finals eight times in thirteen tournaments. A tall, strong right hander, Valerie will be the Hawaii's Leis' number one woman although because of her doubles prowess, she undoubtedly will team with player-coach, Dennis Ralston, in many of the mixed matches.

Her 1972 victory in Philadelphia for the U.S. Nationals title ranked her number 1 Junior Girl player in the U.S. In 1972 Ann won the Hawaii State Open Championship. Since September of 1973, Ann has been playing internationally and joined the Virginia Slims six months ago. At present, Ann is ranked number 16 for women nationally and number 7 in doubles. The draft rights to Ms. Kiyomura were obtained in a trade with Golden Gate for Hawaii's Alex Metrevelli of Russia. A serve and volly player, the Hawaii Leis are looking forward to seeing some great action from Ann.
