

Start out with one of the most respected names in the football coaching fraternity at the helm, Marv Levy. Six times voted coach of the year at the college and pro level. Two Canadian Pro titles in three tries as head coach of the Montreal Alouettes. He rebuilt a decimated Kansas City Chiefs Club from the scrap heap and now he is molding real excitement in Chicago, his home town. Marv's staff of assistants is also deep in successful NFL and Canadian League coaching experience.


