

"Lady Magic"

The single most exciting player in the history of college and pro basketball is returning to Dallas . . . Nancy Lieberman. During her playing career, both at Old Dominion and previously in Dallas, she became the game's most prolific ambassador and spokeswoman.

Nancy led her Old Dominion Lady Monarchs to two consecutive national titles, becoming the second player to reach 2,000 career points at ODU and the all-time leader in steals and assists. Her jersey is to be retired by Old Dominion for the National Basketball Hall of Fame.

The Broderick Cup and the Wade Trophy are just two of the numerous awards bestowed on her along with All-American and MVP honors. As a high school senior, she won a Silver Medal on the 1976 U. S. Olympic basketball team.

"Lady Magic", drafted in the first round by the Diamonds, will bring her magic to Moody Coliseum. The last time she did, she led the Diamonds to a division title.


Head Coach Greg Williams

The Diamonds' court action will be under the direction of new head coach Greg Williams. Greg comes to the Diamonds after two years of WBL experience as assistant coach with the 1979 WBL Champion and 1980 playoff qualifying Houston Angels, compiling a record of 51-26 (.662). Stressing pressure defense and high-scoring fastbreak offense, Greg, along with Assistant Coach Tom Davis, begins the task of building the Diamonds into a championship contender. With the acquisition of new players from the WABA draft and from the ranks of free agents, the Diamonds' promise to be a hustling and exciting team . . . and Coach Williams likes what he sees. His last Diamond team went 27-9 in 1981, remember.
