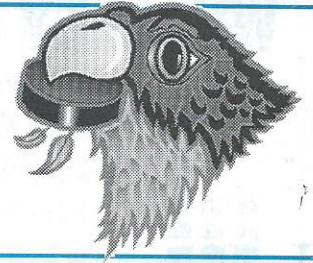

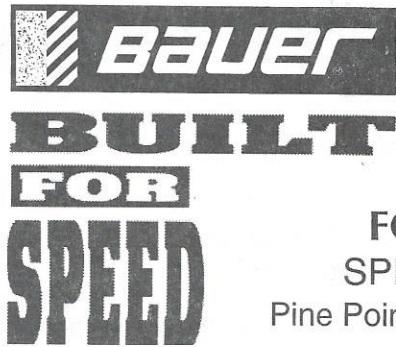

FALCONS FODDER.....

*** The Springfield Falcons hit the ice tonight against the Providence Bruins in a game that could mean a share of first place for the Falcons. Springfield enters tonight's game two points out of first place, trailing Worcester and Portland who are both tied for the number one spot in the New England Division. Worcester does not play tonight, Portland does. A Falcons win, coupled with a Portland loss would put the Falcons in a three way tie for first place in the division. Last night the Falcons defeated the Adirondack Red Wings for the third time this season. The 6-2 victory was sparked by a four goal second period, and a three point night by Chad Kilger. Sylvain Daigle, in his second AHL start, picked up his first AHL victory stopping 26 of 28 Red Wing shots. The win put the Falcons seven games over .500 at the Nest, and eight games over .500 overall on the season. Springfield has now picked up points in four of the last five games on three wins and one overtime loss.

Chad Kilger had his biggest game as a Falcon last night recording three points on one goal and two assists. He now has points in three consecutive games, scoring three goals and three assists during that span. He also has points in seven of the last nine games. Since joining the Falcons on Dec. 6, Kilger has played in 25 games, recording four goals and 15 assists for 19 points.

Juha Ylonen put together another two point game last night with a goal and an assist. With Domenichelli and Brown up with Hartford, Ylonen leads the team with 10 goals and 18 assists for 28 points. He has scored points in four of the last five games.
