

MAKE A POWER PLAY

<u>Tonight's Game:</u> The IceCaps host the Tallahassee Tiger Sharks...It is the second of four meetings between the two teams this season and the second of two in Raleigh...Tonight is the third of six **American Airlines** Trip Giveaway nights, as one lucky fan will win a pair of round-trip tickets to the American Airlines destination of their choice in the continental U.S...Stay in your seats when the second period ends, because the winning seat location will be drawn at the start of the second intermission.

Records: The IceCaps are 20-21-5 on the year with forty-five points...They are in fifth place in the ECHL East, one point ahead of Greensboro...The Tiger Sharks are in third place in the ECHL South with a 21-21-5 record and 47 points...In this season's previous meeting, Tallahassee defeated the IceCaps here on January 20, 5-2...The IceCaps have not lost since then.

<u>Last Game:</u> The IceCaps beat Johnstown here last night, 9-4...It was Raleigh's fifth straight win and their eighth win in their last ten contests...Scott MacNair had a hat trick, the second for the IceCaps in as many games...Lyle Wildgoose, who had the hat trick on Tuesday, had two goals and three assists last night...Marquis Mathieu had a goal and three assists, and Justin Tomberlin had two goals and an assist...Brad Mullahy earned his fifth straight victory in goal with 36 saves...The IceCaps had a season-high 53 shots on goal...They have scored 8 or 9 goals in three of their last four games.

Jobe Milestone: With an assist in the second period last night, Trevor Jobe got the 500th point of his ECHL career...He thus became just the second player in ECHL history to reach the 500 point mark...He added another assist later to finish with three on the night...He has 263 goals and 238 assists in his 265 career ECHL games.

<u>IceCaptions:</u> Wildgoose has points in his last five games and goals in his last four...He has nine points in his last two games...Marquis Mathieu has had back-to-back four point games...Jobe's goal streak ended at four games last night, but he extended his point streak to five games...Tuesday's matchup with Richmond is Raleigh's last home game in February...The team plays its next eight on the road while a boat show and circus occupy Dorton Arena...Raleigh's power play went 3 for 5 last night, and it now ranks 10th in the league at 22.4%...The IceCaps are fourth in penalty killing at 79.7%.
