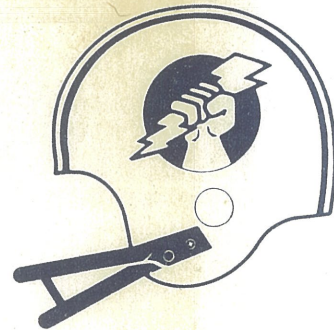

INVADERS HOST BULLS ON ST. PATRICK'S DAY, MARCH 17

Concluding a four-game homestand, the Oakland Invaders (1-1-1) host the Jacksonville Bulls (1-1) this Sunday, March 17, in an effort to get back on the winning track. Kickoff is scheduled for 1 p.m. PST.

Whether the Invaders can benefit from their upcoming meeting with Jacksonville is to be determined, but something that will definitely benefit from the game is the Bay Area Hunger Fund. The Hunger Fund will raise money to feed the hungry in the East Bay and San Francisco based on advance ticket sales and day-of-game ticket sales. (See next page.)

Following an opening-day 31-10 win over the Denver Gold, Head Coach Charlie Sumner's forces have been tied (17-17 by Baltimore) and beaten (42-7 by Houston).

"It's time to turn things around," Sumner said. "Jacksonville has a pretty good team with plenty of good players. It won't be an easy game."

As the team prepares this week to play the Bulls, Sumner indicated he will decide early in the week who will start at quarterback. Against the Gamblers, starting quarterback Bobby Hebert was replaced at halftime by Fred Besana. Hebert completed just 5 of 15 passes for 69 yards and an interception, while Besana could manage to complete just 8 of 18 for 82 yards with 3 interceptions.

"I was looking for someone to give us a spark," Sumner said after the game.

One of the few bright spots on a rainy day was the rushing of fullback Albert Bentley (10 for 77 yards) who scored the club's first rushing touchdown of the season on a 6-yard run in the first quarter. Fullback John Williams also contributed 44 yards rushing on 9 carries.

Wide receivers Anthony Carter (4 for 62 yards) and Gordon Banks (4 for 47 yards) carried the receiving load.

Two players making their 1985 debut were safety David Greenwood and halfback Eric Jordan. Greenwood suffered a knee injury in Game 11 of the 1984 season and responded in his first performance as an Invader with 4 tackles, including a quarterback sack. Jordan, who was the club's leading rusher in 1984 with 744 yards, carried 5 times for 8 yards. Jordan had a roster exemption the first two weeks.

- LAST WEEK:** The Invaders lost their first game of 1985, 42-7, to the Houston Gamblers before 16,037 on a rainy day in the Oakland Coliseum. The Invaders used quarterback Bobby Hebert in the first half and Fred Besana in the second half, but to no avail. FB Albert Bentley rushed 10 times for 77 yards and scored the club's first rushing TD of the season on a 6-yard run in the first quarter. Houston's potent offense saw QB Jim Kelly throw for 404 yards and 4 touchdowns. The Gamblers had scoring drives of 2, 1, 3, 3 and 2 plays, with another score coming on an interception return.
- INJURIES:** S David Greenwood saw his first action since Game 11 of the 1984 season after recovering from a knee injury. DE Bob Standifer (knee) and TE Lewis Gilbert (knee) did not play.
- TRANSACTIONS:** March 6 -- Traded S Marcus Quinn to Tampa Bay for undisclosed draft choices.
March 8 -- Waived FB Otis Brown; re-signed S Lynn Thomas; activated HB Eric Jordan from exempt status.
- INACTIVE LIST:** Last week's inactive list consisted of TE Lewis Gilbert, WR Wes Howell, DE Bob Standifer, S Lynn Thomas, QB J Torchio and DE Darnell Wall.
- SERIES:** The Invaders lead the series, 1-0. On June 2, 1984, the host Invaders beat the Bulls, 17-12. QB Fred Besana set a USFL record with 19 consecutive completions (2 vs. Oklahoma the previous week and 17 vs. the Bulls). He completed 24 of 29 passes for 214 yards and 1 TD, and his 82.76 completion percentage tied a USFL record. FB Tom Newton had solid performance with 72 yards rushing on 10 carries, including a 3-yard TD run.

- RADIO:** KGO (810), the Invaders' 50,000-watt flagship station, will carry the broadcast with Joe Starkey (play-by-play) and Lee Grosscup (analyst). The pregame show starts at 12:45 p.m. PST.
- MEDIA LUNCHEON:** Head Coach Charlie Sumner will be available for media interviews on Tuesday, March 19, at noon. The gathering will occur at the club's practice facility in San Leandro.
