INVADERS HOST BULLS ON ST. PATRICK'S DAY, MARCH 17

Following an opening-day 31-10 win over the Denver Gold, Head Coach Charlie Sumner's forces have been tied (17-17 by Baltimore) and beaten (42-7 by Houston).

"It's time to turn things around," Sumner said. "Jacksonville has a pretty good team with plenty of good players. It won't be an easy game."

As the team prepares this week to play the Bulls, Sumner indicated he will decide early in the week who will start at quarterback. Against the Gamblers, starting quarterback Bobby Hebert was replaced at halftime by Fred Besana. Hebert completed just 5 of 15 passes for 69 yards and an interception, while Besana could manage to complete just 8 of 18 for 82 yards with 3 interceptions.

"I was looking for someone to give us a spark," Sumner said after the game.

One of the few bright spots on a rainy day was the rushing of fullback Albert Bentley (10 for 77 yards) who scored the club's first rushing touchdown of the season on a 6-yard run in the first quarter. Fullback John Williams also contributed 44 yards rushing on 9 carries.

Wide receivers Anthony Carter (4 for 62 yards) and Gordon Banks (4 for 47 yards) carried the receiving load.

Two players making their 1985 debut were safety David Greenwood and halfback Eric Jordan. Greenwood suffered a knee injury in Game 11 of the 1984 season and responded in his first performance as an Invader with 4 tackles, including a quarterback sack. Jordan, who was the club's leading rusher in 1984 with 744 yards, carried 5 times for 8 yards. Jordan had a roster exemption the first two weeks.
