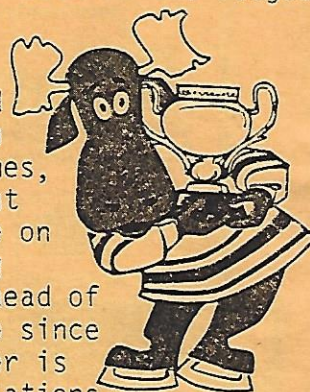

BALTIMORE SKIPJACKS: Lost 8-5 to Springfield Wednesday night...Misleading score as the Jacks scored three of their in the last three minutes of play, 66 seconds apart...# 26 -LW KEITH MILLER started the barrage at 17:48, followed by an unassisted effort by # 21-C STEVE SEGUIN at 18:42, and just 12 seconds later # 19-RW CHARLIE MEITNER finished off Baltimore's scoring...Other scoring: # 28-D WAYNE GAGNE started the game off with his seventh goal of the year at 7:09 of the first period--with an assist on MEITNER's goal, he now has 7 points in his last four games...# 20-LW JACQUES MAILHOT had the other Baltimore goal...# 2-D BOB KENNEDY had two assists in the game...Springfield's lead could have been even greater but for # 31-G MURRAY BANNERMAN's strong performance in the net...Penalty marred game with 125 minutes handed out, including a game misconduct for # 9-D DAVE MOYLAN...# 4-D TIM HOOVER was struck on the foot full force by a puck during the game, but should still see action tonight due to the depleted defensive corps...MAILHOT (severely bruised calf) and # 22-C TERRY PERKINS (back) will sit out...# 14-RW DOUG SHEDDEN, the only Skipjack to play in all 68 games, has passed former Jack Scott Harlow's mark of 69 on the AHL scoring list--his 71 points ranks him 18th in the league

ROCHESTER AMERICANS: Are 6-2 in their last eight games...Lead the season series with Baltimore 7-0-0, tonight's game will wrap it up for the year...Just reacquired # 21-C GATES ORLANDO, who played for them last season and had played in the Italian League earlier this year--ORLANDO had 43 goals and 49 assists in only 38 games with Merano...# 15-LW BOB LOGAN has 7 goals in his last seven games, but unfortunately broke his ankle on Wednesday...3 games in 3,---Tomorrow night they face Adirondack in Glens Falls, then head back to the War Memorial to take on the Hershey Bears...# 22-C BENOIT HOGUE currently has a five game point scoring streak, 3-4=7...# 9-C JODY GAGE's 47 goals leads the AHL, and he remains far ahead of his teammates with 86 points--next closest is Jim Jackson, on recall to Buffalo since last week, along with Mike Hartman...With 12 games left in the season, Rochester is on last season's Southern Division championship pace with 84 points...Congratulations to COACH JOHN VAN BOXMEER--he became a father for the second time one week ago tonight.

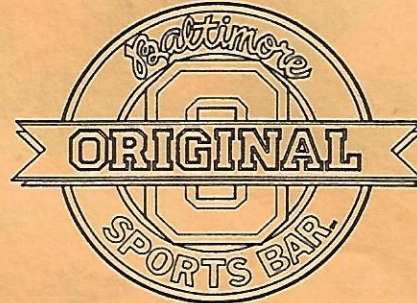
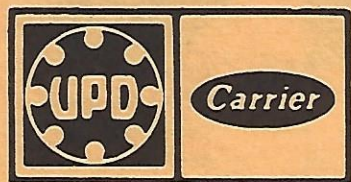
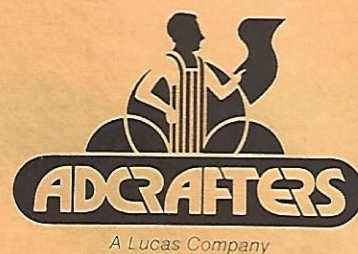

Fans' Scorecard

HOW TO SCORE A JACKS GAME—Keeping an account of tonight's game is easy since the scoreboard and the PA announcer will provide you with all pertinent information.

REFEREE AND LINESMEN—The names of the 3 on-ice officials will be announced prior to the start of the game.

SCORING—When a goal is scored, enter the new score of the game in the first column, JACKS total goals first. Next, indicate in which period the goal was scored and the time. In hockey, time is announced as elapsed time in the period. Place the initial of the team scoring the goal, the name of the player who scored it, and those assisting (if any) in the remaining columns.

DATE March 11, 1988

REFEREE Fausette

PENALTIES—Indicate the period and the time of the penalty, the initial of the team guilty of the infraction, and the player's name who committed the penalty. Complete your entry by writing the number of minutes assessed and the infraction.

GOALS AND SHOTS ON GOAL—At the end of each period, place the number of goals scored by each team and the shots on goal in the appropriate box. The shots on goal totals will be announced over the PA system after the period ends.

THREE STARS—At the end of the game, the players viewed by the media as the top three will have their names announced. Enter their names in the special section.
