SCOUTING REPORT

The Cape Breton Oilers much like the Springfield Indians have enjoyed a turn around season in which they have gone from a last place team to one that has challenged for the top in the division all season...The Oilers finished the year with 85 points and secured home ice advantage in the first round of the Calder Cup Play-Offs...First year coach Don McAdam has efficiently put together a talented group of forwards, along with solid defense and goaltending to formulate a winning combination...

Leading the offensive attack is left wing John LeBlanc...LeBlanc a former Vancouver Canucks leads the Oilers with 54-34--88 points in 77 games...LeBlanc's goal totals are the highest this season by any one player in the AHL...LeBlanc finished the year 8th in league scoring... Another talented Oiler forward is Fabian Joseph who has netted 33-53--86 in 77 games...Joseph is a solid two way player who really controls the game at center and is very good as a penalty killer...If you're looking for size on the wing than check out 6'4" Kim Issel and 6'3" Dan Currie... Currie recorded 76 points in 77 games while Issel racked up 68 points in 62 encounters.

On defense the Oilers have a strong unit...Veterans Wade Campbell, Bruce Bell and Norm MacIver anchor what was a weak part of their game last year...In Goal, rookie Mike Greenlay has a solid GAA at 3.38 and Russian netminder Alexander Tyjnych has a GAA of 4.31.

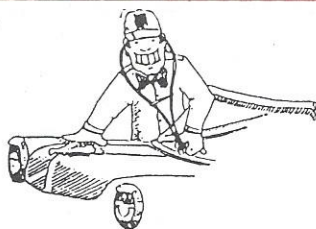

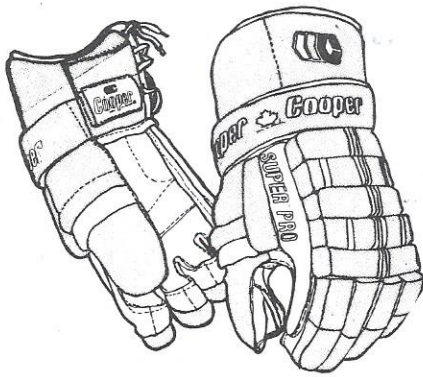

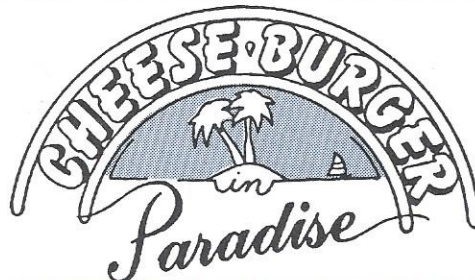

HOW THEY STACK UP...The Springfield Indians finish their 47th season in the AHL at 38-38-4 for 80 points placed third in the AHL's North Division...

STREAKS...The Indians had their season's longest unbeaten stretch (6 games/5-0-1) come to end on the final night of the regular season with a 4-3 loss in Rochester...**IN THE PLAY-OFFS...**The Indians clinched a play-off berth for the first time in five years, when they defeated the Baltimore Skipjacks on Tuesday night...**PLAY-OFF SHOWINGS...**In the eighties, the Tribe has made three previous trips to the post season, swept in four straight games in 1983-84 and 1984-85...Their last play-off victories came in a seven game series with the Maine Mariners in which the Indians lost 4 games to three...**HIGHEST FINISH...**The Indians defeated the Newmarket Saints 7-4 on Saturday night which gave the club 80 points and secured third place in the North Division...The third place finish marks the first time since the 1977-78 season the Indians placed any higher than fourth...**80 POINT SEASON...**The only other time in the past decade when the Tribe finished with 80 or more points was during the 1983-84 season, their record 39-35-6 for 84 points...

LAST FIVE/TEN/FIFTEEN/TWENTY...Indians are 3-1-1 in their last five, 6-3-1 in their last ten, 10-4-1 in their last 15, 13-6-1 in their last 20...

AT HOME/ON ROAD...At home the Indians finished 4-1-0 in their last 5, 7-3-0 in their last 10...On the road, 3-1-1 in their last five, 6-3-1 in their last ten...**MARKED IMPROVEMENT...**The Indians have shown marked improvement over their record of year ago...Last year, the Tribe finished at 32-44-4 for 68 points, scoring 287 goals and allowing 341...This season the Indians have scored 317 goals as a team and allowed 310...The averages work out as follows, last year 3.58 goals per game/4.26 goal against per game...This season, 3.96 goals for and 3.87 goals against per game...

FOR THE MONTH...Indians stand 10-4-1 for the month of March...**BIG**

SHOOTERS...Right wing, Mike Walsh (182), Tom Fitzgerald (159) and Wayne McBean (145) lead the club in shots on goal...**HIGH PERCENTAGE...**In shooting percentage, left wing Dale Henry is pacing the squad with 26.5 %, scoring his 17 goals in 64 shots **PLUS/MINUS...**Defenseman Chris Pryor leads the team in plus/minus at +35...Center Greg Parks is at +32...Shawn Evans is at +29...

STATS AND SUCH...The Indians outshot the opposition 18 times this season with a record of 13-5-0...When the opponents outshoot the record is 23-29-2...Indians were 30-4-1 when leading after two periods...3-27-3 when trailing after forty minutes...

STREAKS...Rob Dimaio currently has a six game goal scoring and points streak, 6-3--9 in his last six...Left wing Rod Dallman has a four game streak at 2-4--6...Center Greg Parks has registered points in four of his last five at 2-5--7...Guy Rouleau has points in four of his last five games at 2-2-4...Tom Fitzgerald has scored at least a point in five of his last seven at 7-2--9...Marc Bergevin has garnered at least a point in in his last 3 at 2-1--3 and point in four of his last five at 2-3--5...Mike Walsh has points in four of his last six at 3-6--9...
