LAS VEGAS SILVER STREAKS VS. WORCESTER COUNTS
SATURDAY MAY 20, 1989 8 P.M. THE CENTRUM

1988 World Basketball League Champions

TONIGHT'S GAME: The second of a four-game road swing....Las Vegas and Worcester meet for the second consecutive night.

LAST NIGHT'S GAME: Three Las Vegas players scored 20 or more points as the Silver Streaks defeated Worcester 111-96.....Las Vegas used a 35-20 score in the third quarter to decide the outcome....Jamie Waller 1ed Las Vegas with a double-double (his second in the last three games) with 24 points and 10 rebounds....Johnny Brown also collected a double-double with 23 points and 12 rebounds, including 10 defensive rebounds....Zack Jones added 20 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals.

RECORD: The Silver Streaks, winning their second straight road game, are 3-2.

FREE THROWS: Las Vegas defeated Worcester despite shooting a season low .474 from the free throw line (9-of-19)...in their last two games, the Silver Streaks have shot only .500 from the line (20-of-40).

THROUGH FIVE GAMES: Las Vegas is shooting .513 from the field (234-of-456) but only .605 from the line (69-of-114)....opponents are .511 from the field (204-of-399) and .769 from the line (120-of-156)...Las Vegas has made only 20 3-pointers (73 attempted) for an average of 4 per game and a percentage of .274....opponents are .369 (27-of-73).

REMAINING ROAD SCHEDULE: Following tonight's game, Las Vegas travels to Springfield...the Silver Streaks play the Express on Tuesday-Wednesday, May 23-24 before returning home on Friday-Saturday, May 26-27 when they face Greece...Greece will be ending its United States tour in Las Vegas.

POINT GUARD HUNTER: Cedric is averaging ll assists per game and only 2.4 turnovers....in 34 minutes of play last night, Hunter had three assists and no turnovers....as a team, Las Vegas committed only eight turnovers...a season low.

BEFORE AND AFTER: The Silver Streaks are 3-0 in games that they have trailed after the first quarter....they are 0-2 in games where they have led after the first quarter.

WALLER: He is the only Las Vegas player averaging more than 20 points a game ...he leads the team with a 22.6 average...he has also scored in double figures in all 51 career games with Las Vegas.
