THE SUN RETURNS TO USL PLAY AT LOCKHART WITH DYNAMOS

The Fort Lauderdale Sun returns to United Soccer League play at Lockhart Stadium, hosting the Houston Dynamos. It is a very important game for both sides.

The Sun is in third place in the USL's Southern Division, but only by one point; they have 21, one less than Jacksonville, which has played eight games to the Sun's five. The Southern Division race grew tighter last night, when Charlotte lost its first match of the season, 1-0 to Dallas. The Americans are Fort Lauderdale's next opponents.

Houston, meanwhile, in in a similar position to Fort Lauderdale. The Dynamos are in third place in the Southwest with a record of 3-5 and 31 points; Oklahoma City leads that division and the league with 48 points, but the Dynamos are only eight behind second place Dallas.

The Dynamos are bringing some familiar faces to Fort Lauderdale. Goalkeepers Mike Barbarick and Roland Sikinger, forwards Jose Neto, Manny Neves and Solomon Hilton have North American Soccer League experience; perhaps the best-known Dynamo to Florida fans is defender Manny Andruszewski, a one-time Tampa Bay Rowdie.

The Sun returns from its road trip and exhibition against Hull City a bit battered. Defender Dave Watson sustained a bruised calf against Hull, while Coach Keith Weller has an aching hamstring; Ron Dufrene is hobbled by a twisted ankle and Nono Jean-Baptiste's knee is bruised. Mark Schwartz is still aching with his hamstring strain and Jim Tietjens' elbow remains sore.

All, however, are expected to be fit for the match.

EXHIBITION GAME PAYS OFF FOR MC CUTCHEON

His play in the Fort Lauderdale Sun's exhibition match against England's Hull City has paid off for University of Miami goalkeeper Jay McCutcheon, for although the young New Jerseyan lost the match (1-0), he won a major battle.

McCutcheon has been signed by the Sun as a backup to Jim Tietjens. He will not, however, dress for tenight's match against the Houston Dynamos.

McCutcheon, 22, is a 5-foot-10, 160-pounder who starred at New Jersey's Mahwah High School before opting for the University of Miami four years ago. He was the Hurricanes' captain and Most Valuable Player in his senior year.

McCutcheon holds a bachelor of arts in broadcasting and interned as a television journalist in the sports department of WTVJ-Channel 4 in Miami.

McCutcheon pleased the Lockhart fans with his performance against Hull, his first-ever performance as a professional. He recorded five saves in the game and limited the visitors to one goal; Hull had earlier demolished the Tampa Bay Rowdies 3-0.

McCutcheon, who is single, still calls New Jersey his place of residence; he is an avid golfer and fisherman and likes to do videotape production in his spare time.
