The Chicago Mustangs will place their 15-game unbeaten streak on the line at Yankee Stadium Sunday afternoon when they face the New York Generals. Game time is 2:30 p.m. It will be ball day with a replica of the Generals North American Soccer League ball given away free to the first 2,000 youngsters, under 18, who purchase a reserved seat. The Mustangs, led by John Kowalik the League's leading scorer with 21 goals, currently lead the Lakes Division. Chicago has not lost since May 3 when they were beaten at Oakland. Included in the streak are eight wins and seven ties.

The Generals on the other hand broke a seven game winless streak Wednesday evening when they beat the Boston Beacons on a late goal by Warren Archibald. The Generals are currently in third place in the Atlantic Division, trailing the Atlanta Chiefs and the Washington Whips.

"Chicago has a strong group", Generals coach Freddie Goodwin said, "This Kowalik is a superb player. He is very fast and knows what to do with the ball when he gets it". The Generals tied Chicago 3-3 two weeks ago and this will be the only other meeting this season between the two club.

Goodwin said he would go with a lineup consisting of Geoff Sidebottom in goal, Barrie Wright and Barry Mahy at the fullback, Laszlo Kaszas, Herb Finken and Gordon Bradley at the halfbacks and Co Prins, Dieter Perau, George Kirby, Warren Archibald, and Julio Alas along the forward line.

There will be a German-American youngster game beginning at 1:15 p.m.
