Game At-A-Glance

U.S.A. RETURNS...

The Independence U.S. National Team players return to the Independence roster this week after a stint with their country over the past two weeks. Lori Lindsey, Heather Mitts, and Amy Rodriguez were all absent from the lineup against FC Gold Pride in California. The Independence players showed well in the two international friendly matches against Sweden. Amy kept her scoring streak going, netting the only goal for the U.S. in the first match. In the second meeting of the two powerhouse countries, Lori Lindsey served up an assist for one of Abby Wambach's two goals.

CLOSING THE GAP...

The gap between the teams at the top of the standings and the bottom of the pack is shrinking. Last weekend, the bottom teams in the league, Boston, Chicago, and Atlanta, all picked up three points and prevented top teams from pulling further ahead. Only FC Gold Pride looks to be out of reach now, pulling twelve points ahead of second-place Philadelphia with a win over the Independence last weekend and another win over Boston mid-week. After being at the bottom of the table for the entire season, Atlanta has earned six points in the past week and is catching up to the rest of the table. With only ten remaining regular season matches for the Independence, every single game is crucial toward earning a playoff spot.

ROUND THREE...

Saturday's game is the third contest between the Independence and Sky Blue FC, and the Independence captured victory in both of the first two meetings. In the first contest, the

Independence came back from a one goal deficit to earn a 2-1 victory at home. In the second meeting, Philly earned a decisive 4-1 win on the road and set the tone for the regional rivals. Philly and New Jersey have home venues less than 80 miles apart are are the two WPS teams located closest in proximity. This weekend will be the third of four regular season battles between the teams this season.

SIMILAR STORIES...

Both the Independence and Sky Blue FC have maintained good footholds in WPS, and have been neck in neck for the entire season. Heading into this weekend's match, the Independence is sitting in second place while Sky Blue FC holds third. The first time they faced off, the two teams were tied with 11 points, and when they played the second time their records were still identical. This time, the Independence is just three points ahead of Sky Blue and is looking to protect its second-place standing.

COACHING CHANGEOVER...

Sky Blue FC has new leadership this weekend, announcing the promotion of Goalkeeper Coach Rick Stainton to the Head Coaching position this week. Pauliina Miettinen and assistant coach Anne Parnila were relieved of their coaching duties with the team mid-week, and Stainton will step into the Head Coach role for the remainder of the season. Sky Blue FC is no stranger to coaching changeover. After going through three coaches last season, Player/Coach Christie Rampone led the team to capture the 2009 WPS Championship.
