GAME NOTES

MINNESOTA STRIKERS AT COSMOS

AUGUST 19, 1984

The Minnesota Strikers enter tonight's match with a 10-7 record for 83 points in the Western Division, 13 points behind division leader Vancouver. They are currently in fourth place of the nine team race for four post-season tournament bids. It is by no means a comfortable position, as two clubs, Toronto (79 points) and San Diego (75 points) are breathing down the necks of the eight year franchise.

The Strikers created a tighter playoff race with their 2-1 loss to the Toronto Blizzard in the Metrodome two nights ago. After two Toronto first half goals, Striker Ray Hudson scored at the 59:43 mark to bring the Strikers to within one goal, but the Blizzard shut the storm windows to ice the eight point victory. The Strikers picked up only one bonus point in the defeat. The loss broke a four game winning streak at the Metrodome for the Strikers.

The Strikers are in the midst of the most grueling part of their 24 game schedule. They have had but one day rest before tonight's contest and after tonight they will play two more games in just four days. In all, the Strikers will have played four games in nine days. If the past is any indication of the future, the Strikers are in for a rough road. They have never beaten the Cosmos in Cosmoland in 10 attemps and they have not beaten their next opponent, Tulsa, in nine straight matches.

IT'S NEVER BEEN DONE BEFORE

Although the Strikers have never beaten the Cosmos on the road, they accomplished one thing they have never done before earlier in the year against the Cosmos, winning two straight. A victory tonight would give the Strikers an unprecedented regular season series sweep of the Cosmos.

The Strikers first defeated the Cosmos on June 30th at the Dome, 1-0 on a first half goal by Brian Kidd. Long Branch, New Jersey native Craig Scarpelli recorded the shutout in his first regular season NASL match. Goalkeeper Tino Lettieri got the win in Round Two when the Strikers edged the Cosmos in the Dome, 3-2 on August 10th. Alan Willey had two goals, his third multiple goal game of the season and fourth game winning goal, to lead the Strikers attack. Former Striker Godfrey Ingram scored the other Striker goal. In that game, midfielder John Bain tied a Strikers all-time record with three assists.

OVER THE YEARS

The Cosmos still have the series edge, despite the Strikers' two game winning streak. Since 1977, the Cosmos have won 15 of 21 games. The Strikers, however, have won four of the last six since 1983.

HUDSON BREAKS ALL-TIME SCORING RECORD

It could have come at a better time, but the magnificence of the record-breaking goal was representative of the great career Ray Hudson has had with Strikers. The two points moved Hudson ahead of former Striker Teofilo Cubillas in the club's all-time scoring list. Hudson now has 181 points on 44 goals and 93 assists in his eight year career. Hudson, who is the Strikers' only remaining original from the 1977 season, took a pass from Peter Daniel, trapped in on his chest and with his back to the goal, lofted a full-volley over his shoulder into the upper left hand corner of the net, past the outstretched hands of Blizzard goalkeeper Paul Hammond.

ETHERINGTON RETURNS TO NEW YORK

He owns two Soccer Bowl rings, and they both say New York Cosmos on them. Etherington, who the Strikers purchased from the New York Arrows of the Major Indoor Soccer League mid-season, was a first round draft choice of the Cosmos in 1977 right out of high school. Etherington was awarded the NASL's Rookie-of-the-Year honor in 1978, playing in 21 games. That year marked the second consecutive season that the Cosmos won the NASL championship. Etherington has since played for the LA Aztecs (1980) and San Jose Earthquakes (1981-82). He did not play outdoor last year.
