Although Shreveport didn't produce a winner this year, the Captain players, management and front office would like to thank all of our fans for their support this season.

For a team that led all of professional baseball in grandslams with 11 in 1979, April 10th and August 13th are important dates to remember in 1980. On April 10th, opening night, Rich Doss hit a grandslam against Arkansas before the largest Shreveport crowd, 1876, in three years to give the Caps a 5-4 win over the Pebbles. Then in an August 13th road game Jim Rothford's "grannie" powered the Caps to a 14-7 victory over the Tulsa Drillers. Last season the Caps hit 10 of their 11 grandslams at home and over the past two seasons the Caps have won every game in which they have unloaded a bases clearing dinger.

The Caps team batting average now stands at .242, up from the .216 mark at first halfs end. JIM WOJCIK (.320) and DAN GLADDEN (.314) continue
