TONIGHT'S GAME: THE UTICA OLYMPICS VS. THE ROCHESTER ZENITHS

THE UTICA OLYMPICS STRUGGLED THROUGH THE MONTH OF DECEMBER WITH A 3-9 RECORD, AND THREE STRAIGHT LOSSES IN JANUARY BEFORE AQUIRING FORMER Z'S: ANDRE MC CARTER AND LARRY MCNEIL, TWO-FIFTHS OF LAST YEAR'S CHAMPIONSHIP ROCHESTER TEAM. THE FIRST-YEAR OLYMPICS ARE PREPARED TO MAKE THEIR MOVE OUT OF THE SOUTHERN DIVISION CELLAR, AND INTO PLAYOFF CONTENTION. GARY MAZZA, A FORMER DETROIT PISTON SCOUT, HAS BEEN NAMED TO PILOT THE OLYMPICS, AFTER ASSISTING IN COACHING DUTIES WITH THE WESTERN BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION'S TUCSON GUNNERS A YEAR AGO(WHERE AL SMITH, A CURRENT Z, LED THE TEAM IN SCORING).

MC CARTER WAS NAMED LAST YEAR'S CBA MVP IN 1978-79, AVERAGING 21.6 POINTS A GAME, AND LED THE LEAGUE IN ASSISTS. MCNEILL FINISHED RUNNER-UP IN OVERALL CBA SCORING AS A ZENITH, AND HOLD THE ALL-TIME INDIVIDUAL SCORING MARK IN THE DOME WITH 44 POINTS (SET LAST YEAR AGAINST JERSEY SHORE). THE OLYMPICS ARE LED BY T.J. ROBINSON- AMONG THE LEADERS IN FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE AND BLOCKED SHOTS, AND WHO ALSO SHATTERED A BACKBOARD EARLIER IN THE YEAR. FORWARD DANNY SALISBURY, A SECOND ROUND PICK BY THE GOLDEN STATE WARRIORS, IS LISTED NEAR THE TOP IN CBA STEALS. CHEESE JOHNSON, THE FINAL WARRIOR CUT IN CAMP, FINISHED SECOND LAST YEAR IN THE MISSOURI VALLEY CONFERENCE, TO LARRY BIRD. HE HAS SCORED 27 AND 23 POINTS AGAINST ROCHESTER THIS YEAR.

THE ROCHESTER ZENITHS WILL BE SHOOTING FOR THEIR NINTH STRAIGHT WIN IN THE DOME TONIGHT, AND THEIR 12TH CONSECUTIVE VICTORY IN ROCHESTER. THE Z'S DROPPED THEIR VERY FIRST HOME GAME THIS YEAR TO LANCASTER, AND HAVE WON EVERY ONE SINCE UNDER PART OWNER AND COACH ART STOCK. THE ZENITH'S SEASON RECORD AGAINST UTICA STANDS 4 WINS-1LOSS, WITH THREE OF THE WINS COMING IN ROCHESTER'S 11-GAME WINNING STREAK CURRENTLY A CBA RECORD.

COMING INTO TONIGHT, AL SMITH IS LEADING ROCHESTER POINT SCORER AND SECOND BEST IN THE ENTIRE LEAGUE, AT 27.5, AND A TWO-TIME CBA PLAYER OF THE WEEK. HE BAGGED 49 DURING THE RECENT ROAD TRIP AGAINST HAWAII, SETTING THE ZENITH HIGH SO FAR THIS YEAR. LARRY FOGLE REMAINS IN THE CBA TOP TEN IN SCORING AVERAGE, AS DOES GLENN HAGAN, PRESENTLY HEADING TWO LEAGUE OFFENSIVE DEPARTMENTS: ASSISTS AND STEALS. LARRY BOSTON, AMONG THE LEADERS IN CBA BLOGKED SHOTS IS AVERAGING 23 POINTS IN HIS LAST FIVE GAMES, AND TIM WATERMAN, IN HIS INITIAL YEAR AS A Z, HAS SCORED 27POINTS TWICE AT THE DOME AGAINST MAINE AND PENNSYLVANIA. JERRY BASKERVILLE, THE Z'S FIFTH -LEADING SCORER, HAS GONE INTO DOUBLE FIGURE'S 11 TIMES THIS YEAR, WITH A GAME HIGH OF 19. KEVIN CLUESS, THE TEAM'S ASSISTANT COACH, HAS PASSED FOR THE SECOND-MOST ASSISTS FOR ROCHESTER, AND HAS CONNECTED TWICE IN THREE-POINT ATTEMPTS. NICK URZETTA AND DAVE EVERETT, THE ZENITH'S DESIGNATED HOME PLAYERS, CONTINUE TO DO WELL OFF THE BENCH. URZETTA, THE HOME-TOWNER FROM BISHOP KEARNYHIGH SCHOOL, IS AVERAGING BETTER THAN FOUR A GAME, AND TALLIED A THREE-POINTER AGAINST UTICA IN THE Z'S FIRST HOME VICTORY THIS YEAR. EVERETT, THE ALL-AMERICAN FROM GRAND CANYON STATE-A LOCAL PRODUCT OF EDISON HIGH, SCORED HIS SEASON HIGH IN THE LAST GAME: 6, AGAINST PENNSYLVANIA. THE NEWEST ZENITH, GREG MILLER, IS AVERAGING 7POINTS IN TWO GAMES PLAYED. HE'S OUT OF BUFFALO STATE UNIVERSITY WHERE HE WAS NAMED MVP AS A JUNIOR AND SET TWO RECORDS IN REBOUNDING. HE BEGAN THIS SEASON WITH THE UTICA OLYMPICS.

CBA PLAYER OF THE WEEK: RON DAVIS, ANCHORAGE NORTHERN KNIGHTS

WHEN RON DAVIS OF THE ANCHORAGE NORTHERN KNIGHTS SCORED 27 POINTS FRIDAY IN A 124-121 LOSS TO THE HAWAII VOLCANOS, IT WAS HIS LOWEST POINT TOTAL IN SIX GAMES. THE 6-7 FORWARD WAS COMING OFF GAMES OF 43,42,36,35, AND 43 POINTS. IN THE THREE -GAME SERIES AGAINST THE VOLCANOS LAST WEEK, DAVIS AVERAGED 35POINTS AND 11 REBOUNDS, GIVING HIM A 34.3 SCORING AVERAGE FOR THE SEASON, HIGHEST IN THE LEAGUE.
