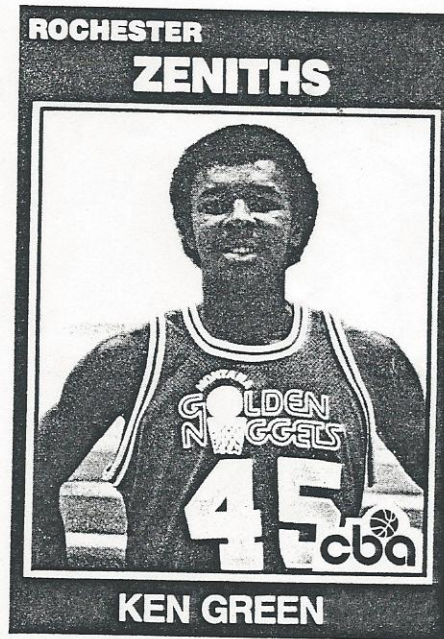

The Rev. Lynn Snyder, pastor of the First Baptist Church in Rockford and the Lightning's team chaplain, will perform the five-minute ceremony.

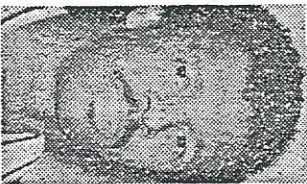
