Skipjacks rookie goaltender JEFF COOPER made his first professional start on Wednesday night in Binghamton, and came away with a stellar 35-save performance to put in the win column. Cooper is a graduate of Colgate University in upstate New York. The Jacks 6-3 win over the Whalers was their second consecutive win, and first on the road. They will meet Binghamton again on Sunday afternoon (2:00 pm) here at the Civic Center.

Jacks have scored 17 goals in just three games, and LW-BOB ERREY can account for six of those goals. Errey is the leading goal-scorer in the AHL to date, and has scored goals in each of the Jacks 3 games. ...Jacks are scoring on 1 out of every 5 shots they take (20% scoring percentage)....Jacks have won five straight games over the Saints at home, running a perfect Civic Center record against them in '84-'85 (5-0-0).

ST. CATHARINES SAINTS:



Saints lost more games than any other AHL club last season and were never able to suit up the league limit of 20 players all season.Fans will see former Skipjack ROD SCHUTT in a Saints uniform, as well as former Amerk nemesis VAL JAMES....When Saints won their home opener last Sunday vs Binghamton, it marked the first time since April 1984 that the team record was over .500....2nd season for COACH ALEXANDER.

AHL PLAYER OF THE WEEK --- Jacks winger BOB ERREY shared the AHL's first "Player of the Week" honor with Rochester's Mal Davis for the week of Oct. 10-13. Errey scored four goals in two games including a hat trick vs Hershey on Sun. Oct. 13.

HOW TO SCORE A **JACKS** GAME—Keeping an account of tonight's game is easy since the scoreboard and the PA announcer will provide you with all pertinent information.

REFEREE AND LINESMEN — The names of the 3 on-ice officials will be announced prior to the start of the game.

SCORING—When a goal is scored, enter the new score of the game in the first column, JACKS' total goals first. Next, indicate in which period the goal was scored and the time. In hockey, time is announced as elapsed time in the period. Place the initial of the team scoring the goal, the name of the player who scored it, and those assisting (if any) in the remaining columns.

PENALTIES—Indicate the period and the time of the penalty, the initial of the team guilty of the infraction, and the player's name who committed the penalty. Complete your entry by writing the number of minutes assessed and the infraction.

GOALS AND SHOTS ON GOAL—At the end of each period, place the number of goals scored by each team and the shots on goal in the appropriate box. The shots on goal totals will be announced over the PA system after the period ends.

THREE STARS—At the end of the game, the players viewed by the media as the top three will have their names announced. Enter their names in the special section.

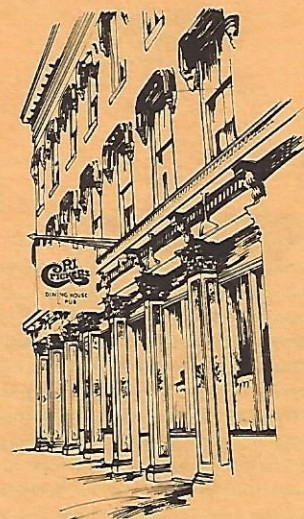
