#### ORLANDO SOLAR BEARS FAST FACTS 12/30/95 vs. Utah - Game #36, Home Game #17

SOLAR BEARS VS. GRIZZLIES...This is the second and final meeting between Orlando and the Utah Grizzlies...Orlando has a 1-0-0 record all-time vs. Utah...the two teams met on 10/14 at the Delta Center...after starting the season 0-4, the Solar Bears picked up its first-ever franchise victory against the Grizzlies, posting a 6-5 win at the Delta Center...Scott LaGrand made 25 saves on the evening for the Solar Bears...Craig Fisher had two goals and two assists, while Jeff Sirkka and Todd Richards each had one goal and one assist...the Grizzlies are led by last year's MVP, Goaltender-of-the-Year, and Rookie-of-the-Year Tommy Salo...he has a record of 14-2-1 and an IHL-best goals against average at 2.18...the Grizzlies' leading scorer is right winger Danton Cole...he has 26 goals and 13 assists for 39 total points...Barry Nieckar leads the club in PIM's with 128...Utah is currently in second place in the Southwest Division, trailing only Las Vegas for the best record in the Western Conference by four points.

LAST TIME OUT...Orlando's Alfie Turcotte scored two goals and had one assist as the Solar Bears held off Detroit and defeated the Vipers, 7-5 at the Orlando Arena on 12/28...Bob Joyce had two goals for Orlando, while Craig Fisher, Hubie McDonough and Dave Barr posted a goal and an assist...Allan Bester was credited for the win for Orlando, making 25 saves on the evening...Detroit's Joe Day had two goals and an assist in the losing cause...the game was played in front of 12,069 at the Orlando Arena...it was the second largest crowd in Solar Bears' history...the largest was opening night, also against Detroit, when 14,112 people came through the turnstiles of the O-rena.

CALLING ALL-STARS...The Orlando Solar Bears will be represented well at the 1996 IHL All-Star Game on January 13 in Houston, Texas...left winger Craig Fisher, right winger Dave Barr and defenseman Todd Richards will join Head Coach Curt Fraser at the mid-season classic at The Summit...Las Vegas and Cincinnati, the leaders in each conference, have the most players on the all-star rosters, each placing five on the team...Orlando, along with Utah and Cleveland, had the next highest total with three representatives.

**HOME SWEET HOME...**Like their sister franchise, the Orlando Magic, the Solar Bears have not made opponent's visits to the Sunshine State a happy one...Orlando is currently on a four-game home winning streak and has won seven of its last eight games at the O-rena...the Solar Bears are currently 12-3-1 at the Orlando Arena and are 12-1-1 in their last 14 games...they have a 11-6-2 mark away from home...this is the Grizzlies' first trip to the Orlando Arena.

SETTING THE TABLE...All-Star defenseman Todd Richards is truly getting into the spirit of the holiday season, giving "gifts" as in the form of perfect passes to many teammates this month...with one assist on 12/28 vs. Detroit, Richards has recorded at least one assist in 11 consecutive games...that sets the IHL season-high this year...he is currently second on the team in assists with 29...the top streak last season was 12 games by Stephane Morin of Minnesota, the scoring champion for the 1994-95 season...last year, Richards finished with a career-high 49 assists.

HE SHOOTS...HE SCORES!!!...The Solar Bears have had little problem when it comes to "lighting the lamp" as of late...over their last 15 contests, Orlando has put the biscuit in the basket 79 times...that is an average of 5.27 goals per game...overall, the Solar Bears are in the IHL's top five, scoring 4.26 goals per game.

WELL, ISN'T THAT SPECIAL...Orlando can thank its special teams for its recent success...Orlando currently has the top ranked power-play in the entire IHL...Orlando is 54-for-210 on the season, good for 25.7%...they have done a good job in killing off their penalties as well...the Solar Bears have given up only 32 power-play goals on 221 opponent chances, good for 85.5% efficiency...that ranks in the top five in the IHL.

MILESTONES TO WATCH...Several members of the Solar Bears are fastly approaching milestones in their porfessional careers...Mike Hartman needs to play in six more games to reach 500, while Mark Beaufait needs to appear in eight more contests for 200 in his career...Beaufait also needs only 11 points to reach 200 in his career...Craig Fisher is just two assists shy of 200, while Jeff Sirkka is six away from the century mark.

**TOUGH STRETCH...**On 12/26 @ Atlanta, the Solar Bears began their toughest stretch of games this season...Orlando will play five games in six days, including three games at the Orlando Arena...they host the Utah Grizzlies tonight...they will then ring in 1996 at Houston for a rematch with the Aeros on New Year's Eve (9:00 p.m.)...during this stretch, Orlando is 2-0-1.

**INJURY REPORT...**Kerry Clark (RW) is questionable with an injured wrist...Joe Frederick (RW) is out due to injured ribs...Mark Beaufait (C) is probable with an injured groin...Bob Joyce (LW) is probable due to an injured knee.




