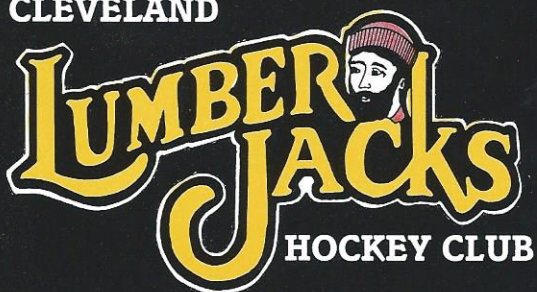

THE IHL AND THE LUMBERJACKS -- "A TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE"

As professional hockey returns to Cleveland for the first time since 1978, the IHL and the Lumberjacks make up a combination which will surely bring the sports fans of northeast Ohio the type of top level entertainment that only the world's fastest team sport can provide! Entering its 48th continuous season of operation, the International Hockey League is one of the most tradition-rich sports circuits in all of North America. Beginning as primarily a midwestern "bus" league, known for its colorful players and penalty-filled games, the IHL has spread its wings throughout the entire country, stretching to such major league cities as San Diego, Phoenix, Salt Lake City, Atlanta, Milwaukee, Kansas City, Indianapolis and now Cleveland. Over the past five years the IHL has experienced a growth rate that is second to none in all of professional sports. Meanwhile, the caliber of play on the ice has improved just as dramatically. Nine of the league's 11 franchises are top developmental teams for the National Hockey League, making IHL hockey the closest thing there is to the NHL. Several of the NHL's current young stars including Kevin Stevens, Mark Recchi, Theo Fleury, Ed Belfour, Mike Richter, Tony Granato and John Cullen developed their skills in IHL arenas. Much like the IHL, the Lumberjacks franchise has distinguished itself as one of professional hockey's most successful, and tradition-rich teams for over three decades. Holding the nicknames Zephyrs, Mohawks and Lumberjacks, the franchise has won over 1200 games in 32 seasons, while capturing 10 overall IHL regular season Huber Trophy championships and four Turner Cup playoff titles. The franchise was born in Muskegon, Michigan in 1960-61, when businessman Jerry P. DeLise, with financial help from Zephyr Oil Co., founded the Muskegon Zephyrs. The Zephyrs moniker remained with the franchise for the next five seasons, during which the club won one Huber Trophy championship and one Turner Cup title. In 1965-66, DeLise changed the team's name to Mohawks, after the highly successful Cincinnati Mohawk teams of the 1950's. Throughout the next 11 years, the Mohawks were one of the most respected franchises on the minor league hockey map. Since the 1984-85 season, the "Jacks have been the most successful team in all of professional hockey, averaging over 50 wins, and 100 points per year, while also capturing six IHL East Division titles, three Huber Trophy overall regular season league crowns and two Turner Cup playoff championships. The IHL and the Lumberjacks have combined to create truly a "Tradition of Excellence" for over three decades, and that tradition will certainly continue in Cleveland in 1992-93 and beyond.

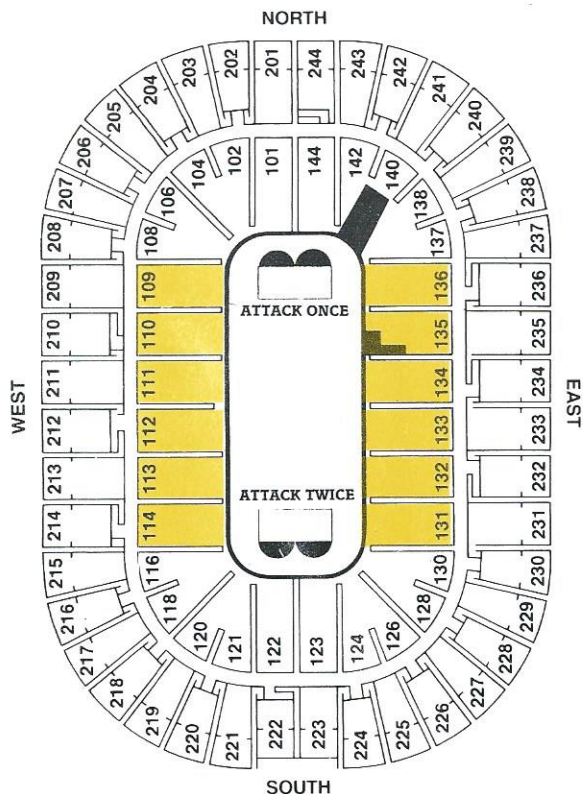
