CHICAGO HORIZONS AT HARTFORD HELLIONS - SAT. FEB. 21 - 7:35 PM

TONIGHT'S GAME - The Hellions look to get back to winning ways after dropping their last 5 games. Currently 4 games out of a playoff spot with 7 to play makes the Hellions chances seem dim. Chicago comes into the Civic Center facing its fourth opponent in five nights and having won 6 of its last 7 matches.

LAST GAMES -

Hartford - In their last contest the Hellions were defeated by the Baltimore Blast 4-3 at the Hartford Civic Center which snapped a four home game winning streak for the Hellions. Baltimore's Nick Mangione scored at 7:54 of the final stanza breaking a 3-3 deadlock giving the Blast the victory.

Chicago - In Cleveland last night the Horizons were defeated by the Force by a score of 4-2. The loss broke a six game winning streak for Chicago and was critical as far as the Central Division standings are concerned with Cleveland holding a two-game lead over Chicago for second place in that division.

NEXT GAMES -

Hartford - The Hellions Travel to Philadelphia to face the Fever in a 4:00 contest at the Spectrum.

Chicago - The Horizons return to the Rosemont Horizon on Wed. Feb. 25 for a 7:35 meeting with the Phoenix Inferno.

LAST MEETING -

The last time these clubs met was on Feb. 1 in Hartford before 7,059 fans. The Hellions came out on top by a score of 3-1 in one of their best outings of the season. Robert Gadocha led the way with 3 goals. It was the first MISL hat-trick for the former Polish Olympic and World Cup star.

PLAYERS TO WATCH -

Hartford -

9 Bill McNicol (F) --- Hartford's leading scorer set a Hellions record for most points in a season with a goal against Baltimore on Thursday night. He establishes the new record with 42 points.

24 Richard But (GK) --- Currently the 5th-leading goalkeeper in the MISL among those who have played in at least half of their team's games. But with a 4.59 goals against average has faced more shots (1,468) than any other goalkeeper in the league. He has also played more minutes (1,856), and is the main reason Hartford's defense has allowed only 157 goals, the second-best total in the MISL only behind New York's 138.

10 Mickey Cave (F) --- The Hellions captain is the second-leading scorer on the club with 22 goals and 14 assists. He is the league-leader in man advantage goals (12), and in penalty kicks with 6, just one shy of the MISL season record of 7 held by Buffalo's Iubo petrovich.

Chicago -

16 Paul Kitson (F) --- The Horizons leading scorer with 27 goals and 17 assists who possesses one of the hardest shots in the league. He is especially dangerous in man-down situations with 5 shorthanded goals to his credit thus far this season which is the MISL single season record in that department.

1 Gary Allison (GK) --- An MISL All-Star selection this year he is the 7th-leading keeper with a 5.01 goals against average. A rugged competitor who has seen action in 24 of his team's 34 contests.

00 Enzo DiPede (GK) --- Has been outstanding since joining the Horizons from the New York Arrows earlier in the year. He has been Chicago's regular goalkeeper lately and for good reason with a 7-3 record and 3.85 goals against average he has been the main reason the Horizons have won 6 of their last 7.

Hartford - Doug Pollard (knee cartilage - may require surgery); Jan Mikulski (injured knee); Mario Garcia (broken Leg (on disabled list); out.

Chicago - Milan Dovedan; Tony Simoes; Les Cmikiewicz; OUT.

HOT TIPS -

***** The Hellions current 5-game losing streak is the longest of the season.

***** Bill McNicol has broken the Hellions record for most points in a season of 41 formerly held by Yilmaz Orhan who now plays for the St. Louis Steamers.

***** Mickey Cave and Dave Mackenzie have both tied the Hellions record of games played in one season held by Paul Toomey with 32. They will both probably break that record tonight.

***** The Hellions will provide a bus for anyone interested in going to the March 5th game at Madison Square Garden. There will be a \$9.50 charge for a round trip bus ticket which will include a keg of beer for the trip.

***** The Hellions have lost 14 one-goal games this year while winning only 4.
