**BALTIMORE SKIPJACKS:** Enter tonight's game with a big boost from the parent club Washington Capitals...Yesterday, the Caps reassigned #19 JOHN DRUCE, #28 CHRIS FELIX and #2 BILL HOULDER to the Jacks and all will appear in tonight's game...The Skipjacks also signed two veteran players yesterday, #27 C DOUG WICKENHEISER and #6 D BRIAN TUTT...Both players had played for Team Canada this year with Tutt appearing in 46 games, scoring 12 assists with 55 PIM and Wickenheiser playing in 26 games tallting 7 goals and 15 assists with 40 PIM...#24 JEFF GREENLAW and #3 DAVE

FARRISH still remained sidelined with injuries and are doubtful for tonight's game...#10 SCOTT MCCRORY remains red hot as he has scored 3 goals and 4 assists in six consecutive games... Scott is currently the league's seventh leading scorer with 32 goals and 42 assists...He is one of three Skipjacks to have played in all 62 games this year...Tonight's game with the Americans is the eighth and final meeting between these two Southern Division rivals...Currently the Jacks lead the series 4-3-0...The teams last met on 2/17 with the Amerks winning 6-3...The Jacks have not lost on home ice to the Americans...The Jacks are 2-3-0 in their last 5 games...Next home game 2/26.

**ROCHESTER AMERICANS:** The Americans have kept their playoff hopes alive in recent days as they have won three of their last four games against Southern Division cpponeents...Last game was against Hershey on 2/12 with the Amerks coming out on top 3-2...The Amerks are 6-3-2 in their last 11 games and they are 5-3-2 for the month of February...On the road they are 3-2-1 in their last six contests and have a 8-23-2 mark in the opposition's rink...Defenseman Joe Reekie has been burning a path between Rochester and Buffalo lately as he was assigned to Rochester 2/17, recalled by Buffalo on 2/19 and reassigned to Rochester again on 2/22...Ken Priestlay has two hat-tricks in his last seven games and recently picked up his second AHL "Player of the Week" award in three weeks as he netted four goals and four assists in three games...He is currently on a 15 game streak (19-15-34) and is tied with Scott McCrory for the league's seventh leading scorer...Rob Ray leads the AHL in penalty minutes with 335, and he now holds the team record for most penalty minutes by a left winger (previously held by Mrk Hartman)...Francois Guay (knee injury) is expected to play today while Scott Metcalfe (shoulder) is day to day...Jim Jackson still remains out with a foot injury...Goaltedner Darcy Wakaluk is still up with Buffalo.

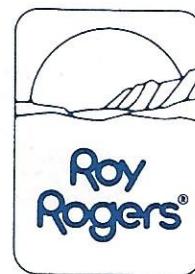

## Fans' Scorecard

HOW TO SCORE A JACKS GAME—Keeping an account of tonight's game is easy since the scoreboard and the PA announcer will provide you with all pertinent information.

**REFEREE AND LINESMEN** — The names of the 3 on-ice officials will be announced prior to the start of the game.

**SCORING** — When a goal is scored, enter the new score of the game in the first column, JACKS' total goals first. Next, indicate in which period the goal was scored and the time. In hockey, time is announced as elapsed time in the period. Place the initial of the team scoring the goal, the name of the player who scored it, and those assisting (if any) in the remaining columns.

**PENALTIES**—Indicate the period and the time of the penalty, the initial of the team guilty of the infraction, and the player's name who committed the penalty. Complete your entry by writing the number of minutes assessed and the infraction.

**GOALS AND SHOTS ON GOAL** — At the end of each period, place the number of goals scored by each team and the shots on goal in the appropriate box. The shots on goal totals will be announced over the PA system after the period ends.

**THREE STARS**—At the end of the game, the players viewed by the media as the top three will have their names announced. Enter their names in the special section.
