The Wrangler / **BLAST** Legend of the Week

Now in his 3rd Blast season, defender Bruce Savage continues to impress with each game and is now considered one of the top, if not the best, all around defenders in the MISL. A native of Hollywood, Florida, Bruce is best known among his MISL counterparts as one of the league's toughest man-to-man markers. He combines terrific defensive smarts with the ability to beat opposing forwards to the ball, and does so without incurring fouls or penalties. In his three MISL seasons prior to this one, Bruce was hit with just 6 penalty minutes, and had not been hit with a PIM after 19 games of the '86-87 campaign.

Earlier this season, Bruce held Wichita scoring ace Erik Rasmussen pointless, marking the first time in 20 regular season games that the high-scoring forward failed to tally at least one point in a game. Just two games later in Dallas, the 2-time All-Star kept Sidekicks' forward Tatu off the scoreboard, as the Blast shut-out the 'Kicks 2-0. Thru 19 games this season, Savage had 2 goals and 4 assists, and was the team leader in blocked shots with 32.
