SEASON SUMMARY: The first half of the season saw the HORIZONS struggling
with an 8-12 record, having been severely handicapped with
injuries. But, with a clean bill of health, the HORIZONS
rallied in the remaining schedule by winning 12 games and
finishing .500 with a record of 20/20 - good for a wildcard
playoff position.

REGULAR SEASON
SERIES REVIEW: The Wings defeated the HORIZONS in the two games the teams
played this season in tight one-goal decisions (5-4 OT and
7-6).

1ST GAME OF
QUARTER-FINAL
SERIES REVIEW:

The HORIZONS defeated the Wings the first game of the best-of-three series of the quarter-final this past Thursday night, March 12 in Rosemont, Illinois at the Rosemont Horizon.

Defenses dominated the first three quarters, neither side pushing extra players forward for fear of being caught on counter attacks.

Chicago took the lead in the first quarter on a Miguel Filardo goal at 8:43 and Paul Kitson made it 2-0 before the half at 9:42 of the second period. That's how it stood through the third quarter, however, the final quarter was worth waiting for.

Wichita's Andy Chapman reduced the deficit for the Wings in the fourth quarter at :46, however, Chicago's Kitson replied quickly with his second goal of the game at 2:30 and Damian Ogunsuyi put the HORIZONS into what looked like a comfortable position scoring Chicago's fourth goal at 6:13. At that point, the Wings threw caution to the wind and attacked HORIZONS Enzo DiPede's goal constantly. Chapman got one back for Wichita at 7:54 and, after Wings Coach Roy Turner pulled his goalkeeper with two minutes left, Chapman completed his hat trick at 14:48 to bring his team within one score of tying the game. Chicago, however, held firm in the final seconds of the game and breathed a sigh of relief to win the evenly fought game 4 to 3.

PLAYERS TO WATCH:
(continued)Goalkeeper DiPede:

Enzo DiPede, led the HORIZONS to the playoffs after regular starter Gary Allison was injured and finished the season with the league's best goals against average of 4.06. However, DiPede only played 16 games, not enough to be named MISL Goalkeeper.

Forward Kitson:

Paul Kitson led the HORIZONS in goals and total points with 33 goals and 18 assists for a total 51 points. He also currently holds the MISL record for shorthanded goals for the season at 6.

Forward Simoes:

Tony Simoes ranked first in assists for the HORIZONS with 25 assists. Simoes is a player with an international reputation. He was the captain for Portuguese power Benfica when the club dominated European soccer in the 1960's and 70's and appeared in 75 international games for the Portuguese national team. Though he is 37 years old, one of the oldest players in the MISL, he is without a doubt one of the most respected players in North American soccer.

- ** HORIZONS captured MISL first place for the most shorthanded goals as a team (10)
- ** Clive Griffiths is the only HORIZONS player to play in all the team's 40 games this season
- ** Clive Griffiths leads the HORIZONS in penalty minutes with 45 minutes and is rated 3rd in the MISL
- ** Gordon Fearnley is the only HORIZONS player not to have spent any minutes in the penalty box this season
- ** Paul Kitson leads the HORIZONS in goals (33), points (51), shots (300), game winning goals (7), and shorthanded goals (6)
- ** Tony Simoes leads the HORIZONS in assists (25)
- ** Damian Ogunsuyi leads the HORIZONS in man advantage goals (10) and game tying goals (2)
- ** Gordon Fearnley, Damian Ogunsuyi and Mauricio Cruz tie as HORIZONS leaders for winning overtime goals (1 ea)
- ** Ben Popoola and Paul Kitson tie as HORIZONS leaders for hat tricks (2 ea.)
- ** Paul Kitson is the HORIZONS Budweiser MVP for the season
