**BALTIMORE SKIPJACKS:** With Wednesday's exciting 6-6 tie versus New Haven, the Skipjacks are now enjoying their longest unbeaten streak of the season, three games...# 14-RW DOUG SHEDDEN, the only Skipjack to play in all 66 games, scored twice, both on the powerplay and in the second period, bringing the team back from a 5-2 deficit--He was named the game's # 1 star...With notching the first goal of the game, # 15-C JEAN-FRANCOIS NAULT has now scored in four consecutive games...# 5-D CLIFF ABRECHT scored his first goal of the season, unassisted, and added two assists on SHEDDEN'S goals...# 28-D WAYNE GAGNE also had two goals, and his shorthanded goal at 17:11 of the second period tied the game up...# 20-LW JACQUES MAILHOT devastated New Haven's John English, who needed 39 stitches to close the cut caused by a second period fight...Newest Skipjack # 25-C GRAEME BONAR should see action tonight, after a long layoff with an ankle injury...# 18-RW BYRON LOMOW was returned from his Colorado assignment in time for Wednesday's game and had the second goal for Baltimore...Back to back games this weekend finds the Jacks facing the Hershey Bears tomorrow, the last time they'll visit Baltimore this season.

**BINGHAMTON WHALERS:** Lost last night, 4-3 to New Haven in Connecticut...# 19-C ROGER KORTKO has points in 8 of his last 9 games, including a goal and an assist in last night's contest...# 24-C MIKE RICHARD was held scoreless, but he leads the Whalers in scoring and ranks # 9 in the AHL--he has 14 points in his last 15 games...Team is 7-4-1 in their last 12 games...They ended February with a record of 6-6-1, which is the first month since November they've finished at least .500...# 1-G KAY WHITMORE has won five of his last six, with a goals against average of 1.50, and a saves percentage of 95.2...# 20-LW TOM MARTIN, 11th in the AHL race, is on a six game point scoring streak (1-7=8) and has points in 12 of his last 13...With two assists last night, # 8-RW MIKE MILLA extended his streak to four games...In their last 11 road games, the Whalers are 3-7-1.

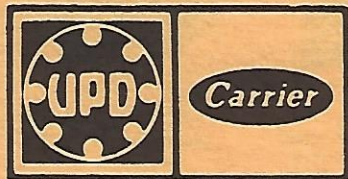

# Fans' Scorecard

**HOW TO SCORE A JACKS GAME**—Keeping an account of tonight's game is easy since the scoreboard and the PA announcer will provide you with all pertinent information.

**REFEREE AND LINESMEN**—The names of the 3 on-ice officials will be announced prior to the start of the game.

**SCORING**—When a goal is scored, enter the new score of the game in the first column, JACKS total goals first. Next, indicate in which period the goal was scored and the time. In hockey, time is announced as elapsed time in the period. Place the initial of the team scoring the goal, the name of the player who scored it, and those assisting (if any) in the remaining columns.

**PENALTIES**—Indicate the period and the time of the penalty, the initial of the team guilty of the infraction, and the player's name who committed the penalty. Complete your entry by writing the number of minutes assessed and the infraction.

**GOALS AND SHOTS ON GOAL**—At the end of each period, place the number of goals scored by each team and the shots on goal in the appropriate box. The shots on goal totals will be announced over the PA system after the period ends.

**THREE STARS**—At the end of the game, the players viewed by the media as the top three will have their names announced. Enter their names in the special section.
