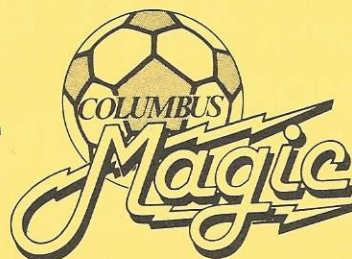

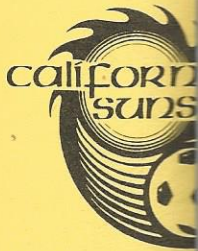

Columbus Magic, a second-year franchise in the American Soccer League, have never lost to the Stoners in two seasons of competition. Most recently the Magic defeated Pennsylvania 2-1 back on May 9th at their Franklyn County Stadium home field.

The Magic reached the 1979 American Soccer League National Championship, playing to an unfortunate 1-0 loss at the hands of the Sacramento Gold.

Tonight will be a homecoming of sorts for Columbus defender, John O'Hara, who was a steady performer for the Stoners last year in their debut season. In fact, O'Hara scored the first goal against his old club in the Magic's May 9th victory over the Stoners.

Once again we will have the opportunity tonight to observe an interesting matchup between a top scorer and high-ranking defense. George Dewsnap leads the Columbus stat sheets with five goals and five assists, while Scott Manning in the Stoners goal has a meager goals against average of 0.93.

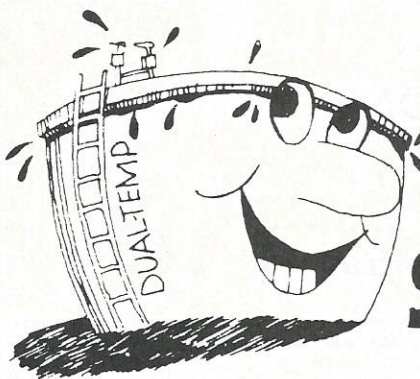

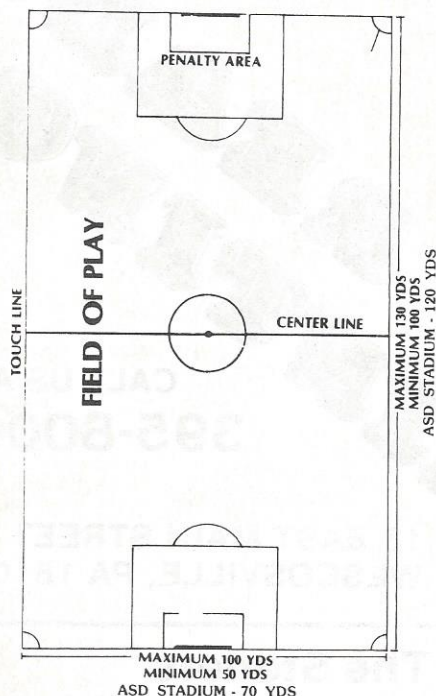

FIELD OF PLAY AND POSITIONS



POSITIONS ON FIELD

GOALKEEPER

He is the last line of defense. Ideally, the keeper controls the whole of the six yard box and with correct judgments, the eighteen yard box. This is his territory. He may take only four steps at a time with the ball in his hands. If more, an indirect free kick is awarded to the opposition.

If the keeper attempts to pick up the ball outside the 18 yard box, a direct free kick is awarded, direct meaning a straight shot at goal.

SWEEPER

The sweeper controls the defense. From his deep position, he communicates with the defenders in front of him. His main responsibility is to ward off any striker who penetrates the defenders ahead of him.

CENTRAL DEFENDER

Usually marks the opposition's central striker. He possesses the ability to jump well and the power and strength to plug up the middle of the defense. His heading qualities are very important.

OUTSIDE FULLBACKS

The modern outside fullback can attack as well as defend. The contemporary term for today's defender in this position is the "overlapping fullback." Normally, these players mark the opposition's wingers.

Overlapping in the sense that you will see him penetrating down the sideline from his defensive position.

MIDFIELDERS

The midfield trio or sometimes, foursome, is commonly referred to as the "cog in the machine." This is the link between the defense and attack. Most attacking combinations are started by the midfield.

They control the area between the two 18 yard boxes. Midfielders have a dual responsibility of both offense and defense, more so than either the defense or attack.

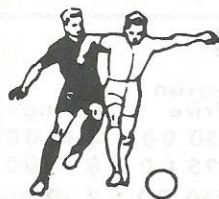
FORWARDS

The forwards or strikers score most of the goals. They are often the end result of much of the combination play between the defense and midfield.

Oftentimes, these players are either the heroes or the goats depending on the final outcome of each scoring opportunity and the game as a whole. Normally, in the modern set-up, there are three strikers. If the midfield is comprised of four players, there will be two strikers and vice versa.



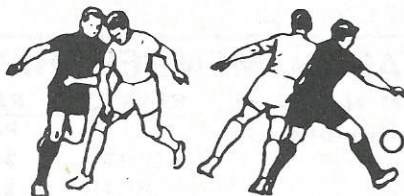
A LOOK AT THE FOULS



Charging opponent from behind. (unless opponent is obstructing).



Jumping at opponent.



When not playing ball, intentionally obstructing opponent; running between him and ball or using body as obstruction to opponent.



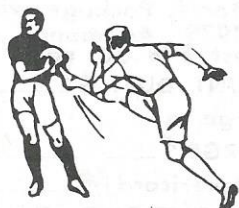
Player beaten to ball, reaches out to hold opponent back from playing ball.



Kicking or trying to kick opponent.



Handling ball (carry, strike or propel ball with hand or arm), but does not apply to goalkeeper within own penalty area.



Playing in way is considered dangerous by referee (trying to kick ball while held by goalkeeper).



Tripping opponent; throwing or trying to throw opponent by stooping or using legs in front or back of him.



Violently or dangerously charging opponent.



Pushing backward with body.
