PITTSBURGH SPIRIT VS. CHICAGO STING

SPIRIT STILL CLING TO
TO PLAYOFF HOPES:

The Pittsburgh Spirit face the Chicago Sting tonight in match that is crucial to the Spirit hopes of making the playoffs. The Spirit enter tonight's game with a 23-23 mark, one-half game behind the New York Arrows (24-23) in the battle for the fourth and final playoff spot in the Major Indoor Soccer League's Eastern Division. A New York victory in their regular season final tomorrow night at Cleveland will send the four-time MISL champion Arrows through to the playoffs. But the Spirit can hardly afford to fret over what may happen tomorrow night with the Force and Arrows. The Spirit need to win their final two games, tonight, and tomorrow night at Pittsburgh's Civic Arena against the Baltimore Blast, if they are to advance to the playoffs for the third time in their four year history.

SPIRIT ON TWO GAME
STREAK VS. STING:

The Spirit have captured the last two meetings between Pittsburgh and Chicago, winning 7-6 (2/12/83) in Chicago on Paul Child's overtime goal and 8-4 (3/4/83) in Pittsburgh as eight different Spirit players scored goals. The Sting won the first contest ever between the two teams when they took a 3-1 decision (1/28/83) in Pittsburgh with the help of outstanding goakeeping by Dieter Ferner.

SPIRIT SPOTLIGHT

STAN TERLECKI: Stan has been on a scoring tear in recent weeks and is one of the big reasons that the Spirit have won eight of their last 10 games. Stan has scored goals in the last seven straight games and has scored at least one point in the last 11 Spirit contests. Over that stretch he has tallied 17 goals and 11 assists. He is the Spirit's leading scorer and the third leading scorer in the league with 65 goals and 39 assists for 104 points. Last week he became only the second player in MISL history to register back-to-back 100 point seasons. Against the Sting this season, Stan has scored three goals and four assists.

GEORGE TIGER: George has scored goals in five of the Spirit's last six games and now has 13 goals and nine assists on the season for 22 points in 37 games. The Spirit rookie has been another key figure down the stretch for the Spirit. He is also second among Spirit forwards with 17 blocked shots.

MARCIO LEITE: Marcio has scored at least one point in four straight games and seven of the last nine Spirit games. Over that stretch he has seven goals and three assists and on the season he has 16 goals and nine assists for 25 points in 36 games, all of which are career highs. He is the Spirit's fifth leading scorer this season.

GRAHAM FYFE: Graham returned to the Spirit line-up in the team's last game against the Memphis Americans after sitting out the last month with a knee injury. Upon his return Graham scored a goal and an assists and now has 16 goals and 14 assists for 30 points in just 20 games this season. Graham is the Spirit's fourth leading scorer this season.

KRYS SOBIESKI: The Spirit's top all-time goalkeeper, Krys has posted a 19-19 won-loss record and a 4.86 goals against average to rank among the league leaders this season. Krys is trying to become the first Spirit goalkeeper to post 20 wins in one season. He also has eight assists on the season, tops this season for goalkeepers. One more assist will equal Shep Messings MISL record of nine assists by a goalkeeper in one season.

JOHN O'HARA: The Spirit captain has been playing outstanding defense for the Spirit down the stretch and also leads all Spirit defenders in scoring with nine goals and 15 assists for 24 points in 38 games. He also leads the team in blocked shots with 66. John's 24 points this season represents a career high for points in one season.

ADAM TOPOLSKI: Adam has been slowed by injuries in recent weeks yet continues to accept the assignment of marking the opposition's top scorer. In 43 games this season Adam has scored 10 goals and 10 assists for 20 points. He is third on the team in blocked shots with 42.

PAUL CHILD: Paul returns to action tonight after sitting out the Spirit's last contest with a one game suspension for his 41st penalty minute of the season. He is the Spirit's second leading scorer this season with 45 goals and 20 assists for 65 points. Paul is just three goals shy of reaching the 100 goal mark for his MISL career. If he gets it he will become just the sixth player in MISL history to reach 100 goals in just two seasons.

PAUL TOOMEY: Paul continues to show the form that makes him one of the top defenders in the league. In 41 games this season Paul has scored five goals and three assists and has also made 36 blocked shots.

DAVE MACKENZIE: A five year veteran of the MISL, Dave leads the Spirit in games played this season with 44. He has scored five goals and 16 assists for 21 points and is second on the team in blocked shots with 60.

PAT MC CLUSKEY: Pat has split his time for the Spirit between the midfield and defense. He recently equaled a MISL record for most penalty kicks in one season (he is seven for seven). In 43 games he has scored 12 goals and nine assists for 21 points. He has also made 35 blocked shots.

STEVE BUTTLE: The Spirit's third leading scorer with 12 goals and 22 assists for 34 points in 33 games, Steve snapped a drought of three straight games without a point when he tallied an assist against Memphis on Saturday.

GREG OSTALCZYK: The quarterback for the Spirit in the midfield, Greg is over the injuries that forced him out of 16 games this season. In 30 games he has scored 12 goals and 12 assists for 24 points.

JOE MORRONE: Joe has played in 32 games for the Spirit this season and has scored nine goals and five assists for 14 points in this, his first MISL season.

JOE PAPALEO: The Spirit's first round draft choice this season, Joe started the last game against Memphis and posted his second win of the season in as many decisions. In six games he has a 4.35 goals against average.
