

## New Jersey Eagles day of game notes, May 6 vs. Tampa Bay

The Eagles had fun practicing in the rain on Friday night, when coach Terry Garbett participated in a one-touch game of "man in the middle" and an intra-squad game with nine players on a side.

Midfielder Paul Duffy, whose ailing back caused him to be substituted for during both games last weekend, practiced with the team this week. He says his back is fine as long as he stretches it out and keeps moving.

Jorge Acosta's right knee will be operated on by Dr. John Xethalis of Lenox Hill Hospital, New York, the same surgeon who operated on Franz Beckenbauer and Angelo DiBernardo of the Cosmos. Acosta, a left-footed kicker, is diagnosed as having torn ligaments in his right knee. At the earliest, he may return near the end of the season. Acosta is remaining active in the organization with community relations work, clinics, and Soccerplex responsibilities.

The Eagles roster remains the same. Paul Riley is unsigned, and is hoping to receive a green card by the end of the month. Defender Peter Gill is also awaiting his green card. The Eagles' other foreigner is forward Pat Hughes.

The Eagles are 2-0 against the Tampa Bay Rowdies, winning home games in 1988 (2-1) and 1989 (1-0). Both the Eagles and Rowdies have beaten the Washington Stars, 1-0, this season.

The Eagles' next two games are on the road. On Saturday, May 12, the team travels to Albany, N.Y., for a 7:35 game against the Capitals. On Saturday, May 19, the Eagles play in Trenton, N.J., against the Penn-Jersey Spirit at 7:35. The next day, Sunday, May 20, the Eagles return to Cochrane Stadium for a 2:00 game against the Fort Lauderdale Strikers.

Mirko Castillo, who signed with the Rowdies two weeks ago and scored in his first game last weekend against the Albany Capitals in a 3-1 loss, tied for the league lead in goals last year (10) and finished second in total points (21) while with Miami. The Rowdies also feature Martin Hill, who tied for third in scoring with 20 points (7 goals, 6 assists) last year. Steve Wegerle, who played in the NASL with the Rowdies and Cosmos, was seventh among scorers last year with 18 points (four goals, 10 assists). Entering 1990, Wegerle was the league's eighth leading all-time scorer (30 points), Hill the 10th leading (25 points).

In 1989, the Rowdies scored 32 goals, only one less than league leaders Fort Lauderdale, and finished in first place in the Southern Division with a 12-8 record before being eliminated in the playoffs by the Boston Bolts, who featured Paul Duffy and Pat Hughes in the lineup.

Rowdies goalkeeper Nick Sakievich, who has played professionally in France (Nantes), Portugal (Belenenses), and the U.S. (N.Y. Arrows, Rowdies), was born in Passaic, N.J., and graduated from the University of New Haven.

Last night in Boston, the Rowdies lost to the Bolts, 1-0, to drop their season record to 1-2.
