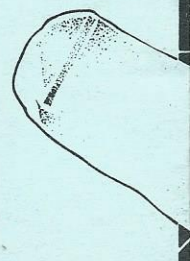

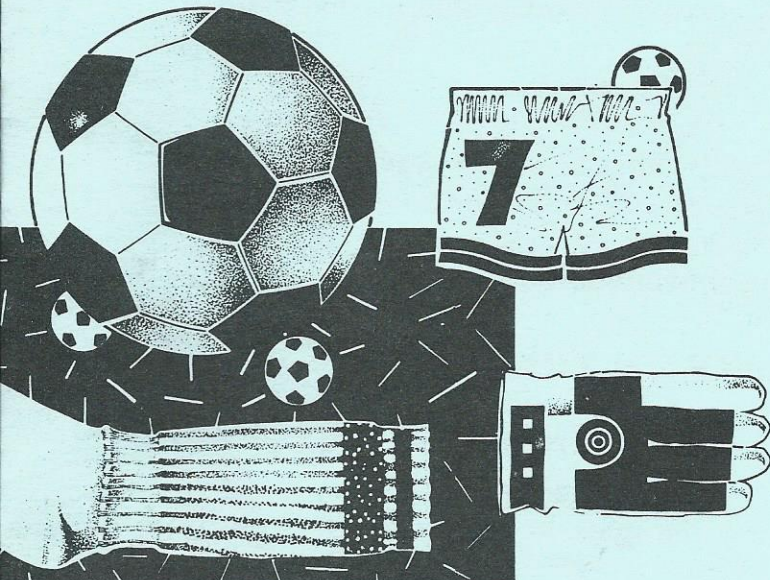

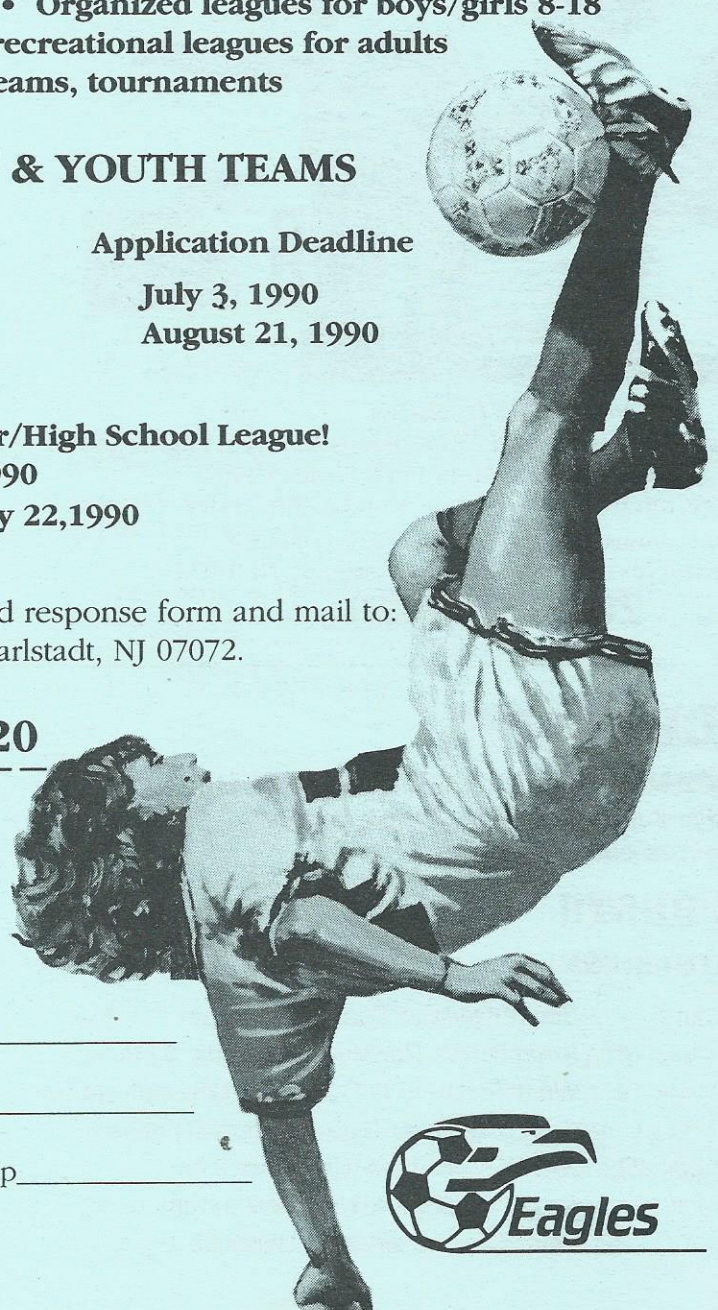

## New Jersey Eagles day of game notes, June 10

Paul Riley entered the weekend third best among league scorers with five goals and one assist for a total of 11 points -- all earned during the Eagles' last two games! Riley, who began his professional career with Albany in 1988 (17 games, 2 goals, 1 assist), has played five games since rejoining the Eagles for the May 19 game against the Penn-Jersey Spirit.

Michael Sweeney of the Boston Bolts tops all scorers with six goals and two assists (14 points), and Ramiro Borja of the Albany Capitals is second with three goals and six assists (12 points). The Eagles' Roger Chavez is eighth best with three goals and two assists (eight points). Elvis Comrie of Albany also has eight points (four goals). Right above him in the scoring table is teammate Mike Masters, who entered last night's game against the Orlando Lions with four goals and one assist (nine points).

The Eagles have scored eight goals in their last two games, both wins, after netting only six in the first eight games. The Eagles are 2-2 at Cochrane Stadium, outscoring their opponents, 12-8.

Forward Winston Buddle, injured in last Sunday's 4-1 win over Miami, is expected to be sidelined for a month. He has a partial tear of the ligament under his right knee. Buddle joined the Eagles less than four weeks ago, playing five games and proving himself an important part of the Eagles attack. It is hoped he will return in time for the July 6 Turnpike Challenge Cup return leg at Cochrane Stadium against the Penn-Jersey Spirit.

Jorge Acosta is rehabilitating his right knee at Sport-O-Rama in Monsey, New York, three times a week, under the supervision of former Cosmos trainer Joel Rosenstein. Acosta is working with weights, stretching and pedaling, and exercising in a whirlpool. He hopes to discard his crutches this coming week. Acosta is not expected to play for the Eagles this season.

Two U.S. national players who started against Czechoslovakia today played for the Eagles in 1988: midfielder Tab Ramos and forward Peter Vermes. Ramos played eight games, contributing two goals and five assists, and Vermes added two goals and four assists in just six games. Both missed many games because of national team commitments. Ramos almost appeared as a guest player in a 1989 exhibition game against Ruch Chorzow.

The Eagles are 3-3 against Albany. After beating the Capitals three times during the inaugural 1988 ASL season, the Eagles lost home (2-1) and away (3-2, penalty kicks) last year, and away (2-0 on May 12) earlier this season. The Capitals are hoping to make the playoffs for the first time after finishing in third place last year (11-9) and last in 1988 (7-13).

The Capitals improved to 7-3 last night in Albany with a 1-0 win over the Orlando Lions.
