AZTECS NEW PLAYER ADDITIONS (As of June 15)

- #24 DAVE LENNARD -- 33 years old, 5-10 and 160...Comes to the Aztecs as a midfielder after old Sacramento Spirits franchise folded in the American Soccer League two weeks ago...Originally from Manchester, England, and former teammate earlier in career of Aztecs Garry Jones when both played at Bolton Park...A seven-year player with Bolton in the English First Division...Married with three children...
- #17 PETER COYNE -- 19 years old, 5-9 and 150...Joins Aztecs following completion of his first year with Crewe Alexandra in English Fourth Division...Previously a reserve team player for two years with Manchester United where he scored 40 goals in each season...Will not turn 20 until November 13...Represented England on the schoolboy level and scored 3 goals in two different games vs. West Germany and Holland, both played in Wembley Stadium...He's a striker...Single:::
- #13 PETER SHORT -- 33-year-old veteran joins Aztecs from the Minnesota Kicks as assistant coach to Tommy Smith...Also member of active roster...Joins Los Angeles as club's new Director of Player Personnel after 10 years in the NASL--the last two as Head of Scouting with Minnesota...Will mostly coach from the bench while player-coach Smith is on the field...

JOINED CLUB EARLIER IN SEASON

- # 6 GARRY JONES -- 27 years old, 5-10 and 165...Came to Aztecs on loan from Bolton Park, where he has played for several seasons...Noted as a goal-scorer...Scored first NASL goal against Chicago Sting in Wrigley Field on May 18 to give Aztecs 2-1 overtime victory...His second and third goals defeated Surf 2-1 on June 17...Married...
- # 7 AUSTIN HAYES -- 19 years old, 5-6 and 135...Comes to the Aztecs on loan from Southampton, England where he was a member of the Southampton reserves...Scored 30 goals there this season and is considered by parent club to be one of their brightest young stars...Has proven a scrapper and plays either forward or midfield...Single...
- # 4 TOMMY SMITH -- 33 years old, 5-10 and 170...Joined Aztecs on May 16 as assistant coach to Terry Fisher and active as a defender...On June 5, became new head coach following Fisher's dismissal...Regarded as one of the best defenders to ever play the game, Smith's Liverpool team has won last two European Cups...Previously played one NASL season in 1976 with Tampa Bay...Married with two children...

AZTECS PLAYER ADDITIONS (June 23)

- # 15    ANDY ROLLAND -- 33 years old, 5-9 and 175...Comes to the Aztecs along with George Dewsnip in the trade from Ft. Lauderdale for George Best on June 23...Considered by many to be the best defender to come out of Scotland in the last 10 years...Prior to starting this season with Strikers in Florida, played for 13 years with Dundee...
- # 11    GEORGE DEWSNIP -- 22 years old, 5-7 and 140...One of the brightest young forwards in the North American Soccer League...With Andy Rolland, was part of the George Best deal with Ft. Lauderdale...Scored three goals in first half of this season with Strikers...Recently married eight weeks ago...Will be an immediate starter at forward...Originally from Manchester, England...
