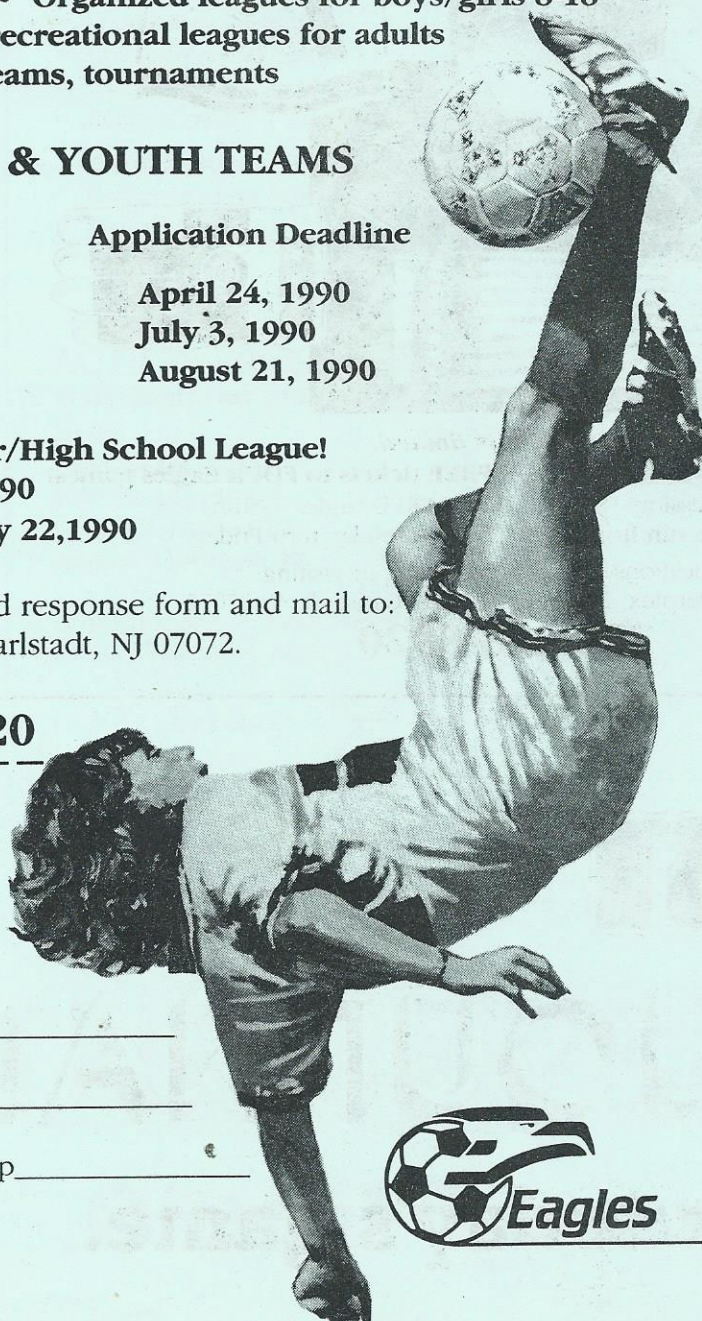

## New Jersey Eagles day of game notes, June 3

Paul Riley's three-goal effort against the Fort Lauderdale Strikers in last Saturday night's 4-3 win in Pompano was the Eagles' first hat trick in over two years. Jorge Acosta scored three goals on April 24, 1988, in a 4-1 win over the Maryland Bays at Hinchliffe Stadium.

Riley said that, prior to heading in three goals in the Fort Lauderdale win, he hadn't headed the ball into the goal in 10 years!

Riley has been assigned a resident alien number, which means that he will be given a green card shortly. That will leave only one foreigner, Dan Hatter, on the Eagles roster. With Acosta now officially on the disabled list while he rehabilitates from knee surgery, the Eagles have one spot open on the roster. The deadline for freezing rosters for the balance of the season and playoffs is June 29.

Midfielder Pete Tadrack, the former East Brunswick High School standout who played professionally with Hershey and Dayton in the American Indoor Soccer Association, has been added to the Eagles supplemental roster and is practicing with the team. Tadrack was originally signed by the Eagles after an impressive tryout during the winter, but was released prior to the start of the season. The Eagles supplemental roster also includes goalkeeper Mike Diamond.

Midfielder Aidan McCluskey, who injured his ankle and knee during the Fort Lauderdale game, practiced with the Eagles during the week and is healthy for tonight's game.

Five Eagles have played every minute of all nine Eagles games this season. They are goalkeeper Hubert Birkenmeier, defenders Kyle Boschen, Sean Crowley, and Nelsi Morais, and forward Roger Chavez. Two others, midfielder Paul Kitson and McCluskey, have started all nine games.

The Eagles lost to the Miami Freedom last Friday night at the Orange Bowl when Fernando Ramos scored the game's only goal at 17:05 into sudden death overtime. Overtime normally lasts 15 minutes; the goal was scored in injury time. The game was played in rain.

The Eagles beat Miami (formerly the Sharks), 4-2, in Florida last year. In 1988, the Eagles won their inaugural league game by beating Miami, 2-1, in Florida. The Eagles also triumphed in the return at Hinchliffe Stadium, 4-0, later that year.

The Freedom (4-3), who lost, 2-1, on penalty kicks to the Capitals in Albany last night, signed forward Steve Kinsey in time for tonight's game. Kinsey entered the 1990 season as the league's second leading all-time scorer, behind Jorge Acosta, with 18 goals and four assists in 23 games with Fort Lauderdale. After tallying eight goals and one assist with the Strikers last season, Kinsey played with the Dallas Sidekicks of the Major Indoor Soccer League. He began his career with Manchester City of the English league.

Richard Schiffman has been appointed chief executive officer of the Eagles and Soccerplex operations. Len Bilous has been promoted to director of operations for the team and manager of Soccerplex operations. Doug Jacobs has been named assistant director of operations and manager of team operations. All three assumed their new responsibilities on June 1.

Schiffman joins the Eagles after a distinguished career on Wall Street. He was a corporate vice president at Drexel Burnham Lambert, where he worked for 20 years. He also spent 18 years at Stern Lauer & Co., where he was a head trader. In the newly created position of CEO, Schiffman concentrates on raising revenues and other business issues.

Bilous now adds team-related responsibilities to his existing duties as manager of the Soccerplex operation. In his new position, Bilous manages player contracts and various other logistics pertaining to the team.

Bilous has an extensive background in soccer. He coached the Cincinnati Kids, Pittsburgh Spirit, and Philadelphia Fever in the Major Indoor Soccer League, and played professionally in the old American Soccer League with the Philadelphia Spartans and Delaware Wings. He also starred at Temple University, where he earned a bachelor's degree in business administration.

Jacobs joins the Eagles on a full-time basis after being involved part-time since 1987. He now manages stadium operations and handles other team-related work, including special ticket promotions. Jacobs received a bachelor's degree in Television/Radio/Film Management from Syracuse University this spring. His background includes a sports internship at WWOR-TV.

Dominick Flora has resigned from his day-to-day responsibilities as vice president of the Eagles, but retains his share of ownership in the team and seat on the board of directors. He will remain involved in corporate marketing for the team through his own company, Flora Marketing Services, which he established prior to helping found the Eagles.
