

BOSTON BOLTS at NEW JERSEY EAGLES Sunday, July 23, 1989

RECORDS: The Bolts are leading the American Soccer League's Northern Division with an 11-6 record and 32 points...the Eagles are in last place, holding a 5-12 record with 17 points.

SERIES: The Eagles hold a 3-2 edge in the all-time series between the two clubs...New Jersey was 2-1 against the Bolts last season...the clubs have split their two games this year, with the Bolts capturing a 5-2 victory here at Hinchliffe on opening day, and the Eagles winning 1-0 in Boston on June 3.

LAST GAME: The Eagles downed the Maryland Bays 2-0 last Sunday on goals by Toma Gojcevic and Jorge Acosta...the Bolts beat the Washington Stars 1-0 in penalty kicks last night.

NEXT GAME: The Eagles are off next weekend...their next game is Saturday August 5 in Fairfax, Virginia against the Washington Stars...they then return home to Hinchliffe to close out the season against the Washington Diplomats.

ACOSTA: Jorge Acosta has scored a goal in three of the five games he has played for the Eagles this season...last year, the ASL's leading scored scored in 10 of 20 games.

DIVISION RACES: The Bolts hold a two point edge over the Albany Capitals (32-30) in the Northern Division...the Washington Stars have 29 points...all three teams have played 17 games.

The South is just as tight, with Tampa Bay holding a 32-30 edge over Orlando, with the Lions holding one game in hand (18-17)...the Diplomats and Strikers are also still in the running with 27 and 26 points respectively.
