Tonight's game serves as the return leg of the first Turnpike Challenge Cup. The Penn-Jersey Spirit won the first game in Trenton on May 19, 2-1. The Eagles, therefore, need to win by a shutout or more than one goal in order to be awarded the cup. If the Eagles win by a 2-1 margin, the cup will be shared by the two APSL ciubs.

New Jersey Turnpike Authority Commissioner Clay Constantinou will formally present the cup to the winning team immediately after the game. Constantinou was an all-conference soccer and tennis player while at Jersey City State College and is a former Cosmos season ticket holder. Constantinou operates a law firm in West Orange, N.J.

Forward/midfielder Winston Buddle is expected to play for the first time since straining knee ligaments on June 3 in the Eagles 4-1 win over the Miami Freedom. The Eagles

are 0-4 since he was injuured.

Recent signees Jack Shannon, a forward/midfielder, forward Dino, and midfielder Mark Shearer are expected to make their Cochrane Stadium debuts tonight along with defender Mark Harris. Shannon and Dino were signed just before the APSL's June 29 deadline for freezing rosters. Shearer played two games in Florida on June 22-23, scoring one goal in Tampa Bay. Harris started both games in Florida after only appearing as a substitute in Washington against the Diplomats on April 29.

Defender Kyle Boschen, whose wrist remains in a cast, is hopeful for next Friday night's game against the

is hopeful for next friday night's game against the Washington Stars. He has been practicing with the Eagles.

Midfielder Aidan McCluskey must sit out tonight's game after accumalating four yellow cards. New signee Franklin McIntosh, a mifielder, must also sit out the game because he was red carded during his last game with the Orlando Lions. Both will be available for next Friday night's game.

Defender Sean Crowley, who has played every minute of every Eagles game this season, and midfielder Paul Kitson are also unavailable tonight. Crowley is on his honeymoon. Kitson is out of the country on personal business. Both will be back for next Friday night's game.

The Eagles are expected to dress only 13 players

tonight.

Penn-Jersey is in first place in the APSL East Northern Division with 31 points from a 10-4 record. The Spirit beat the Strikers in Florida on Tuesday, July 3, 1-0, to overtake the Albany Capitals in the standings.

Penn-Jersey's roster includes six former Eagles: forward Keith Fulk, midfielder Paul Duffy, and defenders George Gelnovatch, Brian Alnscough, Dave Masur, and Rich Maher. Two other former Eagles, Ken Lolla and John Keenan,

were released earlier in the season.

Tonight's game is the first of four Friday night games at Cochrane Stadium. After next Friday's game against the Washington Stars, the Eagles host the Boston Bolts on July 27 and the Maryland Bays in the season figale on August 3.
