WASHINGTON DIPLOMATS at NEW JERSEY EAGLES Sunday, August 6, 1989
Hinchliffe Stadium

RECORDS: The Diplomats are in second place in the American Soccer League's Southern Division with an 11-8 record and 33 points...the Eagles are in last place, in the Northern Division, holding a 5-14 record with 18 points.

SERIES: The Eagles hold a 2-1 edge in the all-time regular season series between the two clubs...New Jersey was 2-0 against the Dips last season...the two clubs then met in the playoffs, with each club winning a regulartion game, and the Dips capturing the tie-breaking mini-game on their way to the ASL title.

LAST GAME: The Eagles lost to the Washington Stars 2-1 yesterday afternoon in Fairfax. VA...Jorge Acosta scored the lone Eagles goal on an assist from Hubert Birkenmeier.

MET LIFE PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Hubert Birkenmeier is leading the season long balloting for the second annual New Jersey Eagles Met Life Player of the Year Award, with 28 points...last year's winner Jorge Acosta, is close behind with 26 points, while all-star midfielder Paul Riley is close behind with 23 points...voting is based on 5 points for a first star, three points for a second star, and one point for a third star vote.

ACOSTA: Jorge Acosta has scored a goal in five of the seven games he has played for the Eagles this season...last year, the ASL's leading scored scored in 10 of 20 games.

DIVISION RACES: The Boston Bolts have clinched a playoff spot, and hold a one point edge over the Albany Capitals (37-36), and a two point edge over the Wahington Stars (35)...Albany has finished their season, so the Capitals playoff chance lie with the Stars-Maryland game today.

The Southern Division is even tighter, with both playoff spots still unclaimed on the final day of play...the Fort Lauderdale Strikers lead the divison with 35 points and no games remaining, trailed by the Diplomats with 33 and the Tampa Bay Rowdies with 32 and one game each to play.

Ties in points shall be broken by the following sequence:

- (a) more total games won
- (b) more games won against other tied club
- (c) more points earned against tother tied club
- (d) more games won against divisional opponents
- (e) total goal difference
- (f) draw or coin toss
