## PELE--"SPORTSMAN OF THE CENTURY"--TO BE NASL'S HONORED GUEST AT SOCCER BOWL-81 IN TORONTO

TORONTO--Sept. 3--Pele, named this past July in an international poll of the world's most influential newspapers as the "Sportsman of the Century," will be the Honored Guest at the North American Soccer League's Soccer Bowl-81 festivities in Toronto, it was announced today by NASL Commissioner Phil Woosnam.

The 40-year old Brazilian-born soccer superstar, will also receive the Variety Club of Ontario's first-annual "Heart of Show Business" Award at the NASL Awards Dinner on Thursday, September 24.

Pele, recognized throughout the world as the greatest soccer player of all time, retired from the New York Cosmos in 1977, after creating instant credibility for the sport in North America by signing with the NASL Cosmos in 1975, and generating increased attendance and media coverage.

He is now an international consultant for Warner Communications, the owners of the Cosmos, appearing world-wide in promoting the game, and recently received the critic's acclaim for his acting performance in the hit movie, "Victory."

In the voting for the world's top athlete, sponsored by "L'Equipe," the French daily sports newspaper which initiated the European Cup, the annual championship for the soccer club champions of each European nation, Pele was ranked above such soccer luminaries as Alfredo di Stefano (Argentina), Sir Stanley Matthews (England), and Johan Cruyff (Holland), the four soccer players to receive votes. In addition, such outstanding athletes as Jesse Owens (track), Eddy Merckx (cycling), Paavo Nurmi (track), Mark Spitz (swimming), Bjorn Borg (tennis), Muhammed Ali (boxing), and Emil Zatopek (track) were ranked below the soccer superstar, who holds the all-time world record for goals with a total of 1,279.

Zatopek, the great Czech long-distance runner, said of Pele's selection as the "Sportsman of the Century:" "Pele's dominance over other footballers is striking. In the No. 1 sport, he is No. 1 without any arguing."

Pele will be the Honored Guest at the League's Gala Awards Dinner held at the Sheraton Centre Hotel, the proceeds of which will go to the Variety Club of Ontario to raise funds for the Variety Village Sports Training and Fitness Center. A special donation will also be made to the Ontario Special Olympics.

Along with Pele, as other guests of the NASL, will be Sir Stanley Matthews, considered to be one of the greatest players in the English First Division, who played till the age of 44, and now resides in Canada; Bill Sterling, President of the Canadian Soccer Association; Gene Edwards, President of the United States Soccer Federation; and J. W. van Marle, President of the Royal Dutch Soccer Federation.

Pele will present the trophies to the finalists and medals to the players at Soccer Bowl-81 on Saturday, September 26, and in so doing, follows in the footsteps of such NASL Honored Guests from previous years as Dr. Henry Kissinger, former Secretary of State of the United States, Sir Stanley Rous from England, Past-President of FIFA, the world governing body of soccer, and Herman Neuberger from West Germany, FIFA Vice President and Chairman of the FIFA World Cup Organizing Committee.
