#### ROAD NOTES

Force Signs Defender: The Force announced January 21, 1982 the signing of Marian Nowacki, a 5'11", 160 lbs. defender from Gdansk Poland, birthplace of Solidarity. Nowacki had tried out with the Force earlier this season and had impressed Coach Eddie McCreadie before sustaining an ankle injury. Nowacki also traveled to Pittsburgh for a tryout with former teammates Stan Terlecki and Krys Sobieski of the Spirit. John Kowalski, head coach of the Spirit was also impressed by Nowacki and recently called to check on Marian's availability.

"I'm pleased he's here" states the Force mentor. "When he came originally we had some visa problems but now everything has been worked out. Marian gives 120% everytime he steps on the field. I need players that will roll up their sleeves and dig in. He's skillful, a strong tackler and he gets forward well."

The 28 year old Nowacki was born in Skalbmierz, Poland. He turned professional in 1972 after completing play for the Polish National Olympic Team. His first professional team was Stal Mielec, followed by two year stints with Legia Warsaw and Arka Gdynia before coming to the United States last fall. During his Polish first division career of eitht years Nowacki scored 58 goals as a defender.

Nowacki will not dress for tonights game due to some minor visa problems and a pulled thigh muscle.

With the problems in Poland, Marian's wife (Helena) and two children (Ewelina, 3 and Sylvia,  $1\frac{1}{2}$ ) have been unable to join him here in the United States

### FORCE SIGNS SCOTT, TAKE TO THE ROAD FOR TWO

#### WUAB TO TELEVISE FROM NEW JERSEY

The Cleveland Force (8-10) will take to the road this week for two eastern division matchups. The New York Arrows (12-3) will host the Force Wednesday night at the Nassau Coliseum. The New Jersey Rockets (4-13) will entertain the Force at the new Meadowlands Brendan Byrne Arena Friday night.

In a Saturday night Richfield Coliseum thriller the Force lost to Wichita 10-9. George Nanchoff scored 5 points and Simon Look added a hat trick but the Force came up one goal short in front of 7,129 ecstatic fans.

In another player move the Force today announced the signing of third round draft choice Derek Scott. Scott who played locally at Cleveland State is a 22 year old 5'9", 165 lbs. midfielder from Sinky Bay, Bermuda. During his C.S.U. career, Derek scord 13 goals and added 13 assists. He was a nominee for the Hermann award, which is the equivalent of football's Heisman trophy, signifying the college soccer player of the year.

"Derek is very quick, he possesses a very strong shot with either foot and will be an asset to our team," stated Force Coach Eddie McCreadie.

The Force has played the Arrows and Rockets once each this year. Back in November the Force lost to the Arrows 11-6 in front of the largest crowd in the history of the franchise, as over 15,000 fans were on hand. In January John Victor, Vic Davidson and George Nanchoff each chipped in a pair of goals to lead the Force attack over New Jersey 8-5.
