

WITH THE BACKS AGAINST THE WALL, THE FORCE MUST WIN TONIGHT OR IT'S ADIOS



But unless they are able to win tonight in the Chicago Stadium there will be no escaping expulsion from the Major Indoor Soccer League playoffs.

The Force, runner-up to Baltimore during the regular season, must win tonight to even up the quarterfinal series at one victory apiece if they hope to advance to the Eastern Division championship series.

But there were several instances during the regular season when the Force needed to win and they were able to do just that.

With the Sting breathing down their necks all season, Cleveland was able to maintain some distance by capturing big games. There was a 6-5 win over Western Division champion San Diego on February 27, when Charley Greene scored with five minutes to play. There was a 9-3 trouncing of then Western Division front-runner Phoenix in Phoenix and there was the 6-3 win over this very same Sting team at the Richfield Coliseum on March 15.

They continued to pull important wins out of their hip pockets down the stretch, starting with the incredible come-from-behind 10-8 win in Buffalo when they scored seven goals in the final 11 minutes of play. They followed that up by pulling off an April Fool's Day 10-7 win over Eastern Division champion Baltimore and a 5-4 win over on-rushing Pittsburgh that wrapped up a playoff spot on April 6.

Another win over the Sting (7-2 in Chicago on April 9) and a season-ending 6-2 rout over four-time defending champ New York all went in to Cleveland's 29-19 record and its second place finish in the rugged Eastern Division.

But all those triumphs and the 29-19 record won't mean much unless the Force can win tonight and then defeat the Sting back in Cleveland on Saturday.

That's what happens when you find your backs to the wall.

SOME THINGS AREN'T FOR SURE

Because of a number of minor, but preventive, injuries, the Cleveland roster has changed since Tuesday night. Not in uniform tonight are goalie Radmilo Ivancevic (#1), defender Gary Vogel (#3), and forwards Ross Ongaro (#9) and Tony Suarez (#18). Ongaro suffered a sprained knee during the 9-5 loss to the Sting on Tuesday. Coach Timo Liekoski was undecided as to whom would dress between George Nanchoff (#14) or Josef Ilic (#15). We will know more at game time.


SOME PLAYOFF STUFF

The loss to the Sting lowered Cleveland's overall playoff record to 1-3. The Force made their initial playoff appearance in 1980-81 and lost the best two-out-of-three opening series to Baltimore.
