

COSMOS VS. CHICAGO STING SATURDAY, JUNE 9, 1984 -- 3:00 P.M. GIANTS STADIUM

TEAM RECORDS: The Cosmos, fresh off their third Trans-Atlantic Challenge Cup Championship, return to N.A.S.L. play with a league record of 2-1 (17 points). The five-time North American champions, after a two-week hiatus from league play, find themselves in an unfamiliar last place spot in the Eastern Division. They stand 17 points behind the division leader and today's opponent, the Chicago Sting (4-2, 34 points). The Cosmos come off à shootout road loss to Tampa Bay (2-3) in their most recent league game on May 26th, but remain undefeated in both league (2-0) and exhibition play (3-0) here in Giants Stadium.

The Cosmos' N.A.S.L. offense is off to a slow start with only 5 goals in 3 games, but the attack showed signs of life in T.A.C.C. action - 9 goals in 2 games (5-3 win over Barcelona, 4-1 win over Udinese).

The Cosmos' defense has given up just 4 goals against league opponents.

The Chicago Sting has won four of their last five games and has an overall record of 4-2. They come off a split of a home-and-home series with Tampa Bay (2-0 loss, 6/1 in Tampa Bay; 3-2 win 6/3 at Wrigley Field) last weekend. The Sting has scored 13 goals and allowed 12. The club is 2-0 in Comiskey Park, 1-0 in Wrigley Field and 1-2 on the road.

TODAY'S TV/RADIO: Today's game will be cablecast live over SportsChannel with Bob Ley and Seamus Malin reporting, and also aired live over WMCA Radio (570 AM) with Jim Karvellas describing the action.

THE SERIES: The Sting holds an overwhelming 11-6 edge in this rivalry including 3 wins in 4 matches last summer. They also handed the Cosmos their only regular-season loss last season in Giants Stadium, a 3-2 win June 22nd behind Karl-Heinz Granitza's 100th career goal. The Cosmos did beat the Sting in their last outdoor meeting 8/21 in Giants Stadium, a 5-3 win that averted a season-sweep by Chicago.

Chicago is the only team to ever win more than once here in Giants Stadium through 108 league games (97-11). The Sting have actually won four times here, including their 4-3 Trans-Atlantic Challenge Cup triumph in 1981.

During the 1983-84 N.A.S.L. indoor season, the Cosmos stunned the Sting in the third game of the best-of-three semi-final to advance to the championship series against San Diego. Overall, the Cosmos took four of six from the Sting in 83-84 indoor soccer regular season play.

AHEAD: The Cosmos make their first of at least four trips to the West Coast this season when they take on N.A.S.L. scoring leader Steve Zungul (6-2-14) and the Golden Bay Earthquakes Wednesday night in Spartan Stadium (11:00 p.m. EDT). They will depart Newark on Tuesday afternoon and return following the game back to Cosmos Country.

The Cosmos-Golden Bay game will be televised live back to the New York/New Jersey area on the WOR-TV Channel 9 superstation with Jim Karvellas and Seamus Malin reporting.
