

COSMOS NOTES

The San Jose Earthquakes sold their 100,000 ticket of the 1974 season on Friday, to become the first team in the North American Soccer League to do so this season. The Earthquakes reached the mark in their seventh home game of the year, vs. the Toronto Metros with an advance sale of over 10,000.

San Jose has been averaging 15,039 per game this season, and expected another large crowd last night.

The Seattle Sounders are also setting attendance records having sold out their last four home games, and have sold out in advance their next home game. The Sounders have been averageing 13,334 per game.

Friday night the Sounders, in their pursuit of the first place Los Angeles Aztecs, were set back by the Miami Toros, in Miami by the score of 2-1. Going into Friday's game the team was led by scoring ace John Rowlands who has 7 goals and 6 assists for 20 points. Trailing Rowlands is David Butler with 7 goals and no assists. Number one draft choice Dave E'Errico has yet to score this season. He has been in a total of 252 minutes of play and has taken three shots. On the other hand the Cosmos free agent, Carlos Scott from Adelphi University, has scored three goals in 275 of play (6 games). Scott has also out shot D'Errico 12-3.

Seattle has one of the toughest defenses with Barry Watling in goal and sporting a 0.71 goal against average. John Best, the Seattle coach, is one of the all-time great defenders in the NASL - having retired from play last season with the Dallas Tornado.

On the road this season the Cosmos have been unable to break into the winning column while the Sounders have an impressive record with 4 wins and three loses. Friday's road defeat was their first away from home since June 1st.

Tim Haag, sports information director at Seattle Pacific College the past three years, has been named Public Relations Director for the Sounders, replacing Hal Childs, who is leaving to assume duties as assistant general manager and director of public relations for the Golden State Warriors of the National Basketball Association.

Eastern has taken an extreme interest in the growth of youth soccer in the metropolitan area, and are also sponsoring this seasons EASTERN AIRLINES MOST VALUABLE PLAYER AWARD. The winner of the award will receive a trophy and check for \$500, courtesy of Eastern Airlines.

The Cosmos next home game is July 28th vs. the Toronto Metros when it will be Country Club Malt Liquor T-Shirt Day, with the first 2,000 youngsters in attendance, receiving a free official Cosmos t-shirt.
