NEW YORK COSMOS vs TORONTO BLIZZARD Tuesday, August 16, 1983

BLIZZARD UPDATE

Tonight's game is the third of a four-game series slated between the Blizzard and Eastern Division opponents, the New York Cosmos. Toronto will wind up its regular season schedule in New York against the Cosmos on Friday, September 2nd.

This is the first NASL home game in over three weeks for the Blizzard following a recently completed three-game road stand and a two-game international series against Benfica of Portugal and Juventus of Italy. The Blizzard's last home game was on Sunday, July 24, a 2-1 victory over the Seattle Sounders.

The Blizzard dropped their third consecutive game of the three-game road stand by a 1-0 score to the Tulsa Roughnecks last Saturday night. Once again, Toronto failed to cash in on some early scoring chances and were the victims of a Tulsa goal by Iraj Danifard in the 57th minute. The Blizzard were forced to finish the game with only 10 men after Jimmy Nicholl was ejected at 67:18 for disputing a yellow-card issued to Randy Ragan.

The loss left Toronto at 13-11 on the season and 112 points, third in the Eastern Division and fifth overall. This is the first time this season the Blizzard have dipped lower than second in the East and third in the league.

Over the past ten games the Blizzard have scored only nine goals. Five of those ten games have gone to extra time with Toronto winning two of three Shootout decisions and losing both overtime decisions.

With six games remaining in the regular season schedule, the Blizzard will face Eastern Division opponents five times. The Blizzard trail the Chicago Sting by 14 points for second place in the Eastern Division and trail Golden Bay Earthquakes by 19 points for fourth place overall and the final home-advantage playoff position. If the playoffs started today, the Blizzard would face current Southern Division leaders, the Ft. Lauderdale Strikers.

LINEUP SHUFFLE

Blizzard leading scorer, David Byrne will miss his first start since joining the Blizzard tonight as he sits out a one-game suspension for accumulating too many yellow-card violations. Byrne played all 18 games of the 1981/82 indoor season, started all 32 games in 1982 and every game so far this season. His absence on the forward line will leave room for Coach Bob Houghton to juggle his lineup. Either Geoff Wegerle or Neill Roberts could be reinstated alongside Roberto Bettega, or both could start with Bettega moving into an offensive midfield role.

Roberts has started 16 games this season but lost his regular position to Roberto Bettega. Roberts' last game was in Seattle on July 30th. He was relegated to the bench for both games in Golden Bay and Tulsa. As a late substitute in the international match against Benfica of Lisbon, Roberts played 53 seconds before setting up Randy Ragan's overtime winner.

Geoff Wegerle has seen only limited action this season in seven games this season. Used mainly as a late substitute he has yet to be selected as a starter. Wegerle has come off the bench to score one goal and an assist plus scoring the winner against Nottingham Forest.

INJURIES

Victor Kodelja will miss tonight's game because of a broken toe suffered during the -Golden Bay game. Cliff Calvert will replace Kodelja at right-back.

Ace Ntsoelengoe, who has missed all but one game this season because of surgery required to repair damaged knee cartilege, will be on the bench tonight. Ace is still not completely match fit but has played a few games with the Blizzard II reserve team in preparation for his return to the lineup and may see some action tonight. The only other game Ace has played in this year was back on May 11 against Tampa Bay, in which he assisted on the first goal. Ironically, Ace played every minute of every game in 1982.

VS NEW YORK COSMOS

The Blizzard have experienced the highs and the lows against the NASL's defending Soccer Bowl champions this season. A 2-1 victory in front of over 25,000 fans was a perfect season opener for the Blizzard on April 24th but the return visit to New York on June 19th proved to be a nightmare. The Cosmos avenged a 4-1 loss suffered at the hands of the Blizzard in 1982 by beating Toronto 5-1, the club's worst defeat this season.

VS NEW YORK - LIFETIME

The Cosmos hold a 10-4 win/loss advantage over the Blizzard since 1979 plus two consecutive victories in playoff action in 1979. The Blizzard lost nine straight games to the Cosmos (including playoffs) until the final game of the 1981 regular season schedule, a 3-2 Shootout victory at Exhibition Stadium. Since then the Blizzard have improved their record against the Cosmos to four victories in their last seven meetings, including a 4-1 win at Giants Stadium in 1982, the Blizzard's only victory in New York and the Cosmos only home defeat in '8
