LAST HOME STAND OF SEASON FOR SOX

This 4-game series with the Lynchburg Mets will conclude the Sox' 70-game home schedule for 1978. After this series, the Sox will travel to Alexandria for a 4-game series Wednesday through Saturday with the season ending for everybody except the two playoff teams on Saturday (Sept.2). The best-of-5 playoffs for the league championship will begin on Sunday, Sept. 3. The playoffs will match the First Half Champion Lynchburg Mets against the Second Half Champion -- which at this writing -- appears to be the Peninsula Pilots.

Here is some recent playoff history:

- 1970- W-S Red Sox, led by such players as Juan Beniquez & Lynn McGlothen, defeated Burlington in best-of-3 series, 2 games to 0.
- 1971- Peninsula defeated Kinston 2 games to 0.
- 1972- Salem Pirates, led by Dave Parker, Ed Ott and Dogg Bair, defeated Burlington Rangers, led by Mike Cabbage, 2 games to 1.
- 1973- W-S Red Sox, led by Steve Dillard, Al Ryan, Ernie Whitt, Chuck Erickson, Bill Moran, Jim Wright and Barry Sbragia, defeated Lynchburg Twins in best-of-5 series 3 games to 2.
- 1974- Salem Pirates, led by Larry Demery, Miguel Dilone and the late Alfredo Edmead, won both halves of season. No playoffs.
- 1975- Rocky Mount Phillies, led by Jim Morrison and Warren Brusstar, won both halves of season. No playoffs.
- 1976- W-S Red Sox, led by Otis Foster, Ron Evans, Puchy Delgado, Ken Huizenga, Paul McClure, Mike C'Berry, Breen Newcomer and Ron Herlihy, won both halves of season. No playoffs.
- 1977- Peninsula Pilots, led by John Hughes, Luis Aguayo, Len Matuszek, Orlando Sanchez, Louis Reyes, Ramon Lora, Frank Lucy and Jeff Schneider, defeated Lynchburg Mets, led by Butch Benton, Robert Bryant and Neil Allen, 3 games to 2.

MONAHAN ASSIGNED TO KINSTON FOR REMAINDER OF SEASON -- Brian Monahan, Sox reliever, was assigned to Kinston Eagles on August 17 for balance of season due to injury to Kinston pitcher Dave Schoppee, who is Boston Red Sox property and had been pitching for Eagles this year. Kinston is a co-op club, meaning its players belong to many different big league organizations.
