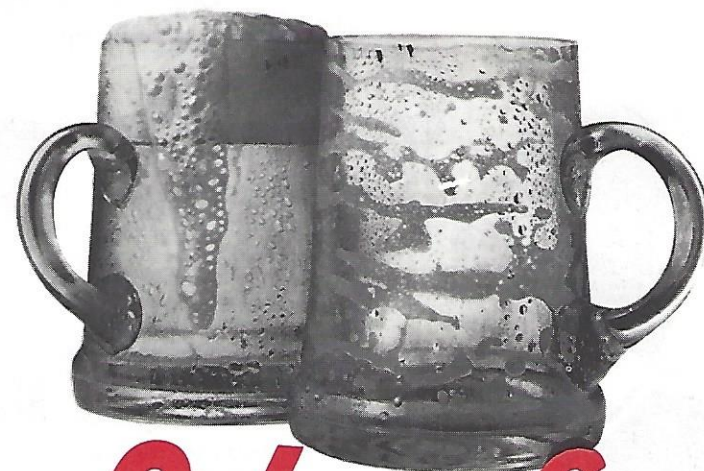

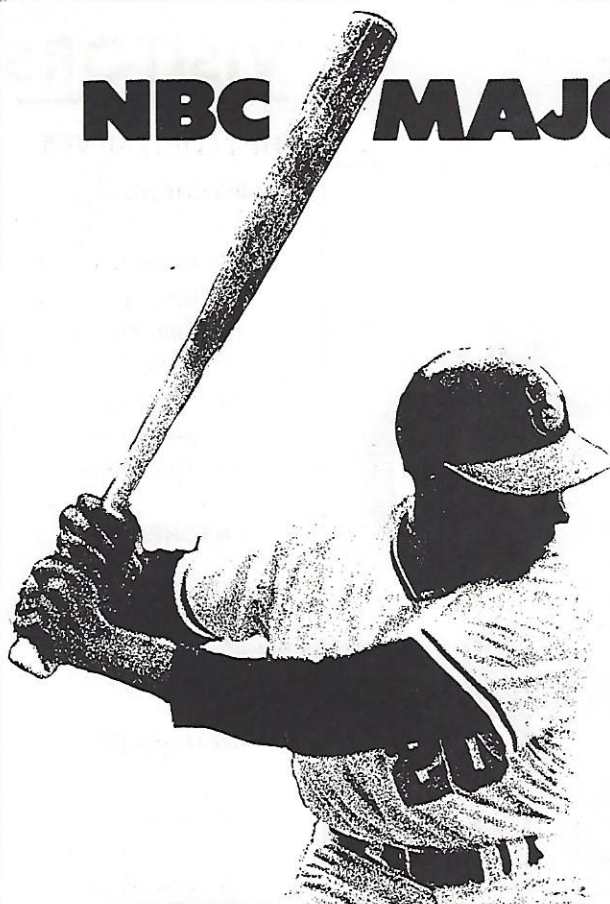
The Red Sox return home Wednesday to start a nine day homestand. Hosting Waterbury, Three Rivers and Reading.

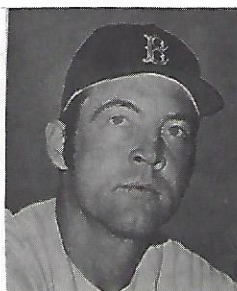
STEVE BARR

The All-Star lefthander led the league with 16 wins and 15 complete games, posting a 2.45 ERA in 1974.



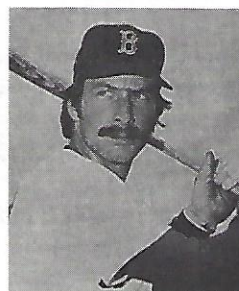
JIM RICE

An Eastern League All-Star outfielder in 1973, Jim led the league in hitting with a .317 average and was second in home runs with 27 and RBI with 93.



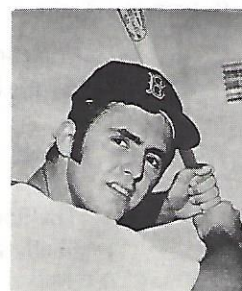
STAN WILLIAMS
