LAS VEGAS THUNDER

Did You Know?



- The Las Vegas Thunder began play in the 1993-94 season. They are not an NHL affiliate...
- Las Vegas acquired right wing Grigori Panteleyev from the Utah Grizzlies on February 6 in exchange for right wing Marc Rodgers and defenseman Jeff Sharples. Panteleyev reunites with Sergei Zholtok, the IHL's Player-of-the-Month for January. They have played together during each of the last nine seasons, including last season with Providence (AHL).
- The Thunder acquired left wing/center Guy Larose and center Joe Day from the Detroit Vipers on February 6 in exchange for all-star center Todd Simon and all-star right wing Daniel Shank. Larose was Detroit's top goal-scorer and Day is an effective two-way player who had 19 goals for Detroit this season. Simon and Shank are among the top-10 in IHL scoring.
- Las Vegas head coach Chris McSorley is the brother of Los Angeles Kings defenseman Marty McSorley. His wife, Carrie, is a country music singer and a former Miss Tennessee.
- McSorley is in his first year as head coach of the Thunder. He served as an assistant to last year's head coach and present general manager Bob Strumm. McSorley coached for five seasons in the East Coact Hockey League and posted a 196-106-30 record. In 1993, he coached the Anaheim Bullfrogs of Roller Hockey International to the RHI title. He played five seasons in the AHL and IHL, registering 67 goals and 73 assists for 140 points and 1,587 penalty minutes in 244 regular season games. Last season, when injuries hit the Thunder roster, he was activated and played in two games, scoring no points with 20 penalty minutes.
- The Thunder play in the Thomas & Mack Center, home of the UNLV Runnin' Rebels basketball team. They are sixth in IHL attendance this season, averaging 7,776 fans per game...
- Las Vegas and L.A. have met three times this season. On October 6, L.A. dropped a 9-4 decision at Las Vegas. On Nov. 11, L.A. lost 5-1 here at the Sports Arena. And on Nov. 24, the Thunder won by an 8-2 score. The Ice Dogs and Las Vegas meet in L.A. one more time this season, on Saturday night, Mar. 30; the game can also be seen live on Prime Sports.
- Las Vegas is 37-12-7 with 81 points, in first place in the Southwest Division. They lead second place Utah by eight points and the third place Ice Dogs by 23 points. They lead the IHL in points, two points ahead of Eastern Conference-leading Cincinnati. They also lead the IHL in wins, goals scored, penalties, penalty minutes and a host of other categories.
- Leading scorers for Las Vegas include RW Patrice Lefebvre (31 goals-53 assists-84 points) and center Sergei Zholtok (21-31-52). D Greg Hawgood (16-49-65) is the leading scorer among IHL defensemen (six points ahead of second place, Dan Lambert of the Ice Dogs). G Pokey Reddick is 17-9-3 with a 2.87 goals against average, and backup Jim Hrivnak is 6-0-1 with a 3.29 GAA. Hrivnak joined the Thunder after Curtis Joseph departed to sign with the NHL's Edmonton Oilers. D Jeff Ricardi leads the team with 235 penalty minutes in 54 games. D Peter Fiorentino has 159 PIM in 43 games. Five Thunder players have more than 100 PIM.
